

GO! Scrappy Pineapple Quilt

Finished Size: 40" x 50"



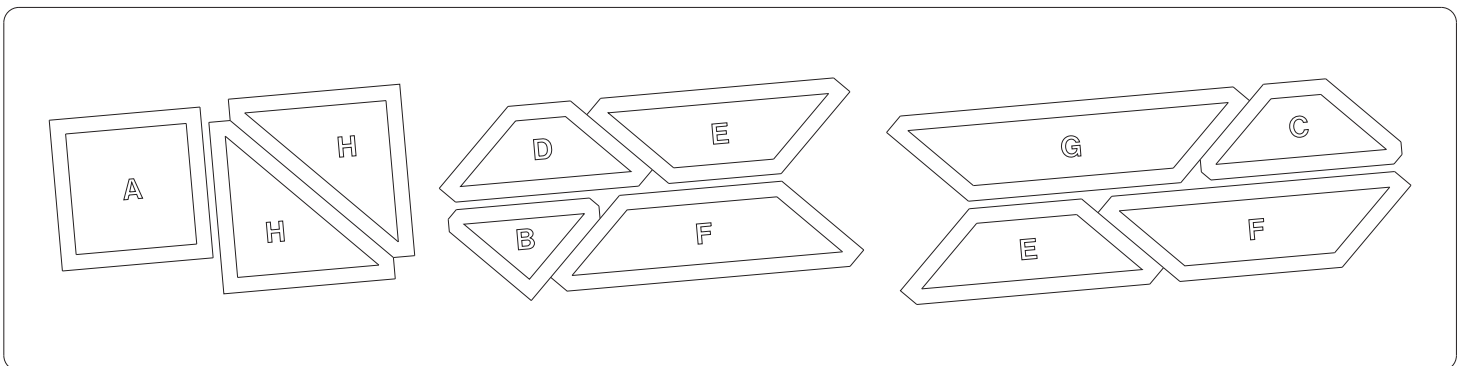
Dies Needed:

- GO! Pineapple-10" Finished (55485)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032)

Fabric Color	Shapes to Cut	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Black	GO! Pineapple (Shape A)	Cut 1—3" x Width of Fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold and lay on shape A. Sub cut out 12 squares.	½ yard
Black	GO! Pineapple (Shape H)	Cut 3—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold and lay on shape H. Sub cut 48 half square triangles (HSTs).	Yardage included above
White	GO! Pineapple (Section B, D, E, F)	Cut 5—7½" x WOF strips. Fanfold and lay on section B, D, E, F. Sub cut 48 of this section.	1½ yards
White	GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished)	Cut 2—5½" x WOF strips. Place on die and sub cut 4 strips.	Yardage included above
Dark Blue	GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished)	Cut 2—7½" x WOF strips and 1—4" x WOF strip. Place on die and sub cut 5 strips.	5/8yds
Scraps!	GO! Pineapple (Section C, E, F, G)	Cut 48 scrap rectangles measuring 9" x 3¾". Lay on die and cut out 48 of this section.	1¼ yards, total scraps

Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Batting: 44" x 54"
- Backing: 46" x 56"



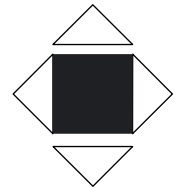
Sewing Directions:

Press all seams toward each new piece added and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated



Pineapple Block

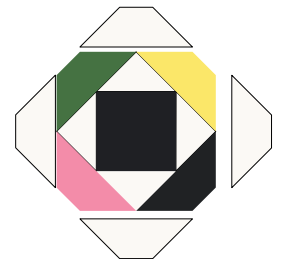
1. Sew a white "B" triangle to side of black "A" square. Repeat with remaining 3 "B" triangles.



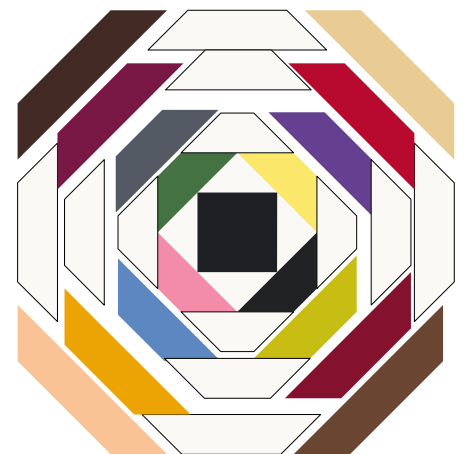
2. Sew a scrappy "C" shape to sides of block in the same way as above. Repeat with remaining 3 "C" shapes.



3. Sew a white "D" shape to sides of block. Repeat with remaining "D" shapes.



4. Continue making block with white and scrappy sections; scrappy "E" shapes, white "E" shapes, scrappy "F" shapes, white "F" shapes and lastly scrappy "G" shapes.



5. Lastly, sew black “H” triangles.
6. Make 12 blocks total.



Quilt layout

1. Lay out the blocks in a 3x4 layout and sew together in rows, then sew rows together to make center of quilt.
2. Trim two white 2½" strips to 40½" and sew to sides of quilt. Press toward strips
3. Trim remaining two white 2½" strips to 34½" and sew to top and bottom. Press toward strips.
4. Cut one blue 3½" border strip in half and sew to ends of two other blue border strips. Trim both to 44½" and sew to sides of quilt. Press toward strips.
5. Trim remaining two blue 3½" strips to 40½" and sew to top and bottom. Press toward strips.



Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners
