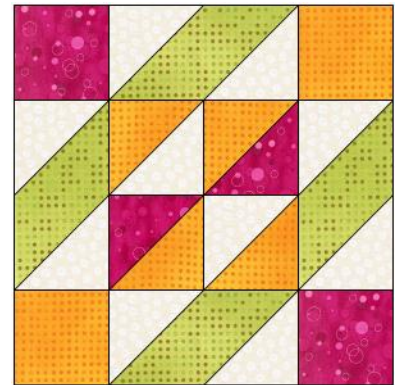


## GO! Trellis 8" Block Pattern





Finished Block Size 8" x 8"



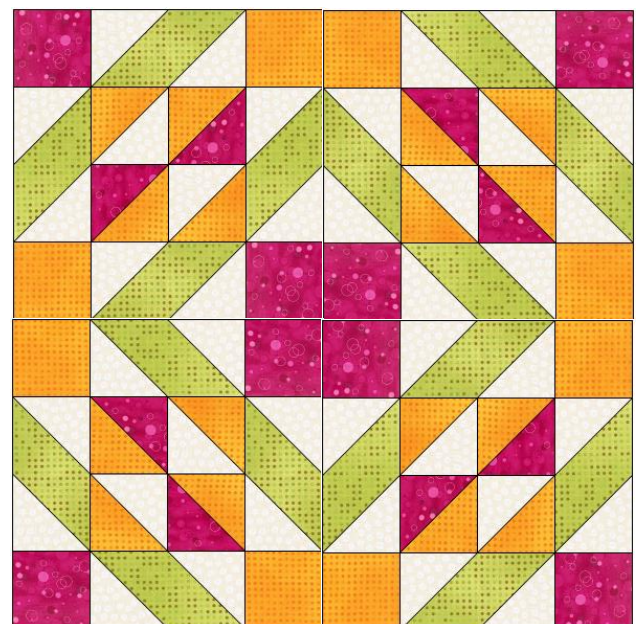
### GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements

White		GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square Multiples (55063) or GO! Value Die (55018)	10	1/8 yard
Orange		GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) Multiples (55059) or GO! Value Die (55018)	2	1/8 yard
Orange		GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square Multiples (55063) or GO! Value Die (55018)	4	Yardage included above
Pink		GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) Multiples (55059) or GO! Value Die (55018)	2	1/8 yard
Pink		GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square Multiples (55063) or GO! Value Die (55018)	2	Yardage included above
Green		GO! Parallelogram 45°- 2¾" x 3½" Sides (2¹⁄₁₆" x 2¹³⁄₁₆" Finished) (55318)	2 as shown	1/4 yard

### Block Sewing Directions

1. Pin and sew one pink and one orange 2" finished half square triangle (HST) together as shown. Press seam toward pink triangle. Make two HST units. 
2. Pin and sew one orange and one white 2" finished HST together as shown. Press seam toward orange triangles. Make two HST units. 
3. Pin and sew four HST units together as shown for block center unit. 
4. Pin and sew two white 2" finished HSTs and one green parallelogram together as shown. Press seams toward white triangles. Make two combined top and bottom parallelogram units. 

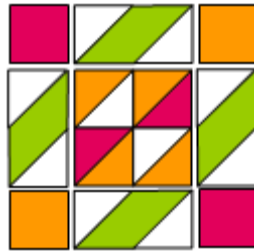
### Alternate Four Block Option



5. Pin and sew two white 2" finished HSTs and one green parallelogram together as shown. Press seams toward white triangles. Make two combined side parallelogram units.



6. Pin and sew one side parallelogram unit to each side of block center unit as shown. Press seams open.



7. Pin and sew one pink and one orange 2" finished squares to ends of one side parallelogram unit. Make two combined units.

8. Pin and sew one combined unit to top and bottom of block center to complete block. Press seams open.

**TIPS:** Twist and turn blocks for interesting and colorful geometric combinations.
