

GO! Spring Medley Table Runner

Finished Size: 32" x 12"





Dies Needed:

- GO! Spring Medley (55494)
- GO! Qube™ Mix & Match 8" Block (55776)
 - GO! Square-2½" (2" Finished) (Shape 2)
 - GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

Cutting Directions:

**NOTE: Apply fusible web to the wrong side of asterisked fabrics following manufacturer's instructions before cutting appliqué shapes.*

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Light Purple	 5	Cut 2—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 36—2" finished half square triangles (HSTs).	¾ yards
White	 5	Cut 2—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 36—2" finished half square triangles (HSTs).	1 ¼ yards

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
White	2	Cut 1—5½" x 5½" square. Sub cut into 4—2" finished squares.	Yardage included above
White	GO! Square-8½" (8" Finished) (55058)	Cut 1—9" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 9" widths. Sub cut into 4—8" finished squares for applique background.	Yardage included above
*Assorted Fabrics	GO! Spring Medley (55494)	Cut 5¼" squares. Cut 1 each—chick and basket, cut 2—bunnies and egg shapes. One bunny will be cut fabric wrong side up and one fabric right side up.	Assorted Coordinated Scraps

Additional Cutting Instructions:

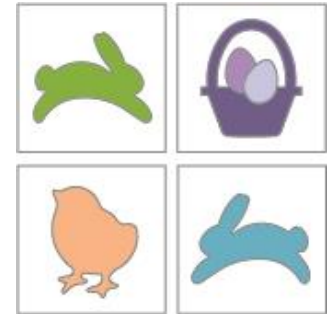
- Light Purple—Yardage included above
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) to cut 2—2½" x WOF strips for 2" x 6" vertical rectangles and binding.
 - Use GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024) to cut 2—1½" x WOF strips for 1" x 28" horizontal inner borders.

Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Fusible Web: 1/4 yard
- Batting: 40" x 20"
- Backing: 40" x 20"

Embroidery Directions: Spring Medley Blocks

1. The GO! Spring Medley (55494) shapes will be stitched onto a white 8½" background square. Place tear-away or cut-away stabilizer and 8½" background fabric squares into your embroidery hoop. With the design open in the embroidery machine, note whether the design is facing right or left and use the mirror function in the embroidery machine to adjust the design accordingly. Use the free machine embroidery download found at www.accuquilt.com/springmedley55494 or your own favorite embroidery stitch.



2. When stitching is complete, remove 8½" square from embroidery hoop. Trim square to 6½" with the design centered in the square.

Sewing Directions:

Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Sew one light purple and one white 2" finished HST (Shape 5) together as shown. Press seams open. Make 36 HST units.



2. Sew two HST units together as shown. Press seams open. Make 18—2" x 4" finished HST units.



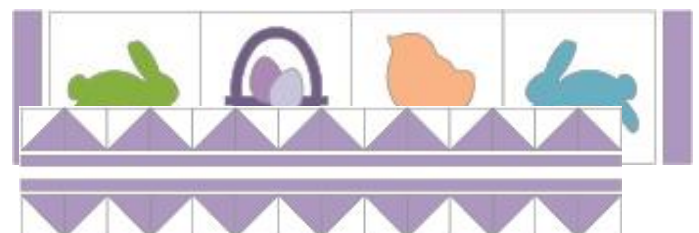
3. Sew 7—2" x 4" finished HST units together to make a top border as shown. Repeat to make a bottom border. Press seams open.



4. Sew 2—2" x 4" finished HST units together to make two side borders as shown. Press seams open.



5. Stitch embroidery blocks together as shown. Stitch 2½" x 6½" rectangles to either end of embroidery blocks as shown. Press seams open.



6. Assemble top and bottom borders. Stitch 1½" x 28" narrow borders to HST borders. Press toward narrow border.

- Assemble side borders. Stitch one white 2" finished square (Shape 2) to either end of both of the side borders. Press seams open. Make two side borders.



Assemble Quilt Blocks

- Lay out and stitch the top and bottom borders to the center embroidery panel as shown.
- Lay out and stitch the side borders to the center of the table runner as show.



Quilting and Finishing

- Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
- Pin or baste layers together.
- Quilt as desired.
- Add binding, mitering corners.
