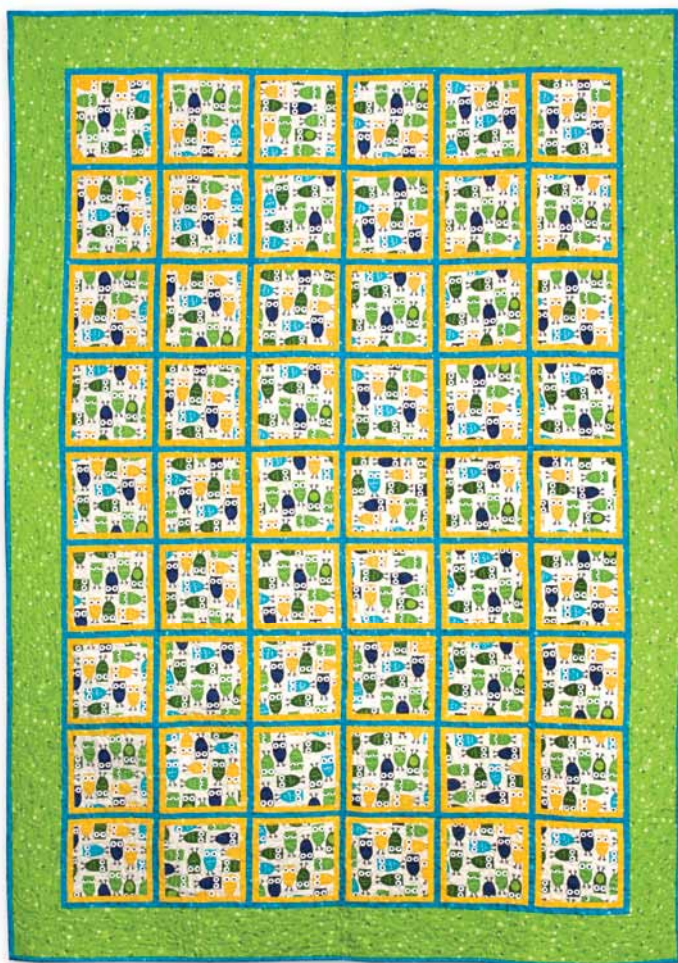


## GO! Boxed In Quilt

finished size 51" x 74"

finished block size 7" x 7"



### GO!® DIES USED:

- Squares-6½" (55000)
- Strip Cutter-4½" (55054)
- Strip Cutter-2½" (55017)
- Strip Cutter-1" (55052)

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—2¼ yards
- Fabric 2—1 yard
- Fabric 3—1⅓ yards
- Fabric 4—1½ yards
- Backing Fabric—3¼ yards
- Batting—57" x 80" rectangle

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 54—6½" squares

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 7—4½" strips across width of fabric (WOF) for outer border

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 7—2½" strips across WOF for binding
- Cut 24—1" strips across WOF for sashing and inner border  
*Sub cut 9 strips into 45, 1" x 7½" rectangles*

#### Fabric 4:

- Cut 44—1" strips across WOF for block frames  
*Sub cut 22 strips into 108, 1" x 7½" rectangles; sub cut 22 strips into 108, 1" x 6½" rectangles*

**TIP:** Lay each strip set on GO! Squares-6½" (55000) perpendicular to blades to cut into 6½" lengths.

### SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Pin and sew one Fabric #4, 1" x 6½" rectangle to each side of one Fabric #1, 6½" square. Press seams toward rectangles.
2. Pin and sew one Fabric #4, 1" x 7½" rectangle to top and bottom of combined square. Press seams toward rectangles. Make 54 blocks.
3. Layout blocks for one row, according to diagram, with Fabric #3, 1" x 7½" vertical sashing rectangles.
4. Pin and sew blocks and vertical sashing together. Press seams toward sashing. Repeat for nine rows.
5. Pin and sew Fabric #3, horizontal sashing between rows according to diagram, piecing together as needed. Press seams toward sashing.

## SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

6. Add Fabric #3, inner border strips to sides of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.
7. Add Fabric #3, inner border strips to top and bottom of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.
8. Add Fabric #2, outer border strips to sides of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.
9. Add Fabric #2, outer border strips to top and bottom of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.

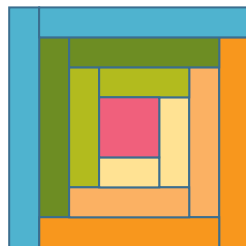
## QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

## OPTIONS

- Use your favorite AccuQuilt GO! appliqués on squares
- Feature embroideries on squares
- Also good for using a favorite printed novelty fabric
