GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Square-8½" (55058)
- GO! Square-6½" (55000)
- GO! Square-4½" Multiples (55060) or GO! Value Die (55018)
- GO! Half Square-4" Finished Triangle (55031)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter-6½" (55086)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1⅞ yards
- Fabric 2—1¾ yards
- Fabric 3—⅔ yard
- Fabric 4—1½ yards (includes binding)
- Fabric 5—⅜ yard
- Backing—3½ yards
- Batting—63" x 79"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric 1:

- Cut 18—8½" squares
- Cut 28—4" finished half square triangles

Fabric 2:

- Cut 6—6½" strips across the width of the fabric (WOF) for outer border
- Cut 16—4½" squares

Fabric 3:

- Cut 5—2½" strips across the WOF for inner border
- Cut 8—4" finished half square triangles

Fabric 4:

- Cut 7—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 4—6½" squares
- Cut 16—4½" squares
- Cut 16—4" finished half square triangles

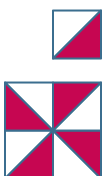
Fabric 5:

- Cut 20—4" finished half square triangles





SEWING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Press seams toward the darker fabric, for the least bulk or as directed.

1. Make 20 half square triangles using Fabric #1 and Fabric #5, 4" finished half square triangles.
2. Pin and sew four Fabric #1 and Fabric #5, 4" finished half square triangles together into a pinwheel. Press seams in a counter clockwise direction. Pinwheel center to press flat. Make five pinwheel blocks.



SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

3. Make eight half square triangles using Fabric #1 and Fabric #4, 4" finished half square triangles. 
4. Make eight half square triangles using Fabric #3 and Fabric #4, 4" finished half square triangles. 
5. Pin and sew two Fabric #1 and Fabric #4 and two Fabric #3 and Fabric #4, 4" finished half square triangles together to form an hour glass block as shown. Make four hour glass blocks. 
6. Pin and sew two Fabric #2 and two Fabric #4, 4½" squares together to form a 4-Patch block as shown. Make eight blocks. 
7. Lay out pieced blocks and Fabric #1, 8½" squares for quilt center following quilt diagram.
8. Pin and sew rows together. Press seams toward 8½" blocks.
9. Pin and sew Fabric #3, 2½" inner border strips together into one long strip.
10. Pin and sew Fabric #3, 2½" inner border strips to quilt center, sides first, then top and bottom. Press seams toward inner border.
11. Measure width of quilt center: _____.
12. Pin and sew Fabric #2, 6½" outer border strips together into one long strip.
13. Pin and sew Fabric #2, 6½" outer border strips to sides of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.
14. Trim two Fabric #2, 6½" outer border strips to width of quilt center measured in Step 11 for top and bottom outer borders.
15. Pin and sew one Fabric #4, 6½" square to each end of top and bottom outer border strips. Press seams toward squares.
16. Pin and sew combined outer border strips to top and bottom of quilt center. Press seams toward inner border.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
