### GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Strip Cutter-5½" (55026)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Circle-2", 3", 5" (55012)
- GO! Carefree Numbers (55099)

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—⅞ yard
- Fabric 2—½ yard
- Fabric 3—¼ yard each of four prints
- Fabric 4—½ yard (includes binding)
- Fabric 5—⅛ yard
- Fabric 6—⅜ yard
- Fabric 7—⅜ yard
- Fabric 8—⅛ yard or fat quarter
- Fusible web—1 yard
- Backing—3 yards
- Batting—51" x 51"

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics following manufacturer's instructions for appliqué shapes.

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 4—5½" x 34½" rectangles for outer border

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 4—2½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF) for inner border  
Sub cut into 2—2½" x 34½" strips; and 2—2½" x 30½" strips
- Cut 3—3" circles
- Cut 3—2" circles

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 1—5½" x 30½" rectangle (from each fabric)
- Cut 1—5½" square (from each fabric)

#### Fabric 4:

- Cut 5—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 2—3" circles
- Cut 2—2" circles

#### Fabric 5:

- Cut 1—2½" x 30½" rectangle
- Cut 1— number 3
- Cut 1—3" circle
- Cut 1—2" circle

#### Fabric 6:

- Cut 2—2½" x 30½" rectangles
- Cut 1— number 2
- Cut 2—3" circles
- Cut 2—2" circles

#### Fabric 7:

- Cut 2—2½" x 30½" rectangles
- Cut 1—number 1
- Cut 1—number 4
- Cut 1—3" circle
- Cut 3—2" circles

#### Fabric 8:

- Cut 3—3" circles
- Cut 1—2" circle

## SEWING DIRECTIONS

**NOTE:** Press seams toward the darker fabric or for the least bulk.

1. Lay out the 11, 30½" horizontal strips for quilt center following quilt diagram.
2. Pin and sew together.
3. Pin and sew one Fabric #2, 2½" x 34½" inner border rectangle to sides of quilt center.
4. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
5. Lay out circles on Fabric #1, 5½" x 34½" outer border rectangles following quilt diagram.
6. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions.
7. Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine.
8. Center one number on each 5½" border square. Fuse and appliqué.
9. Pin and sew Fabric #1, appliquéd outer border strips to sides of quilt center.
10. Pin and sew one appliquéd border square on each end of top and bottom outer border strip.
11. Pin and sew Fabric #1, expanded appliquéd outer border strips to top and bottom of quilt center, matching seams.

## QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
