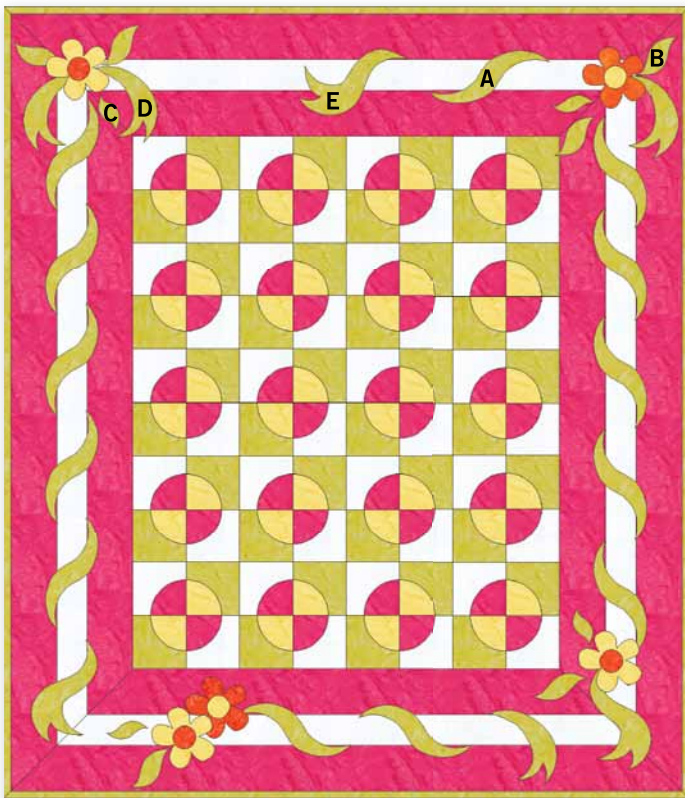


GO! Twisted Ribbon Quilt

finished size 45" x 52"

finished block size 7" x 7"

GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Ribbon Twist (55055)
- GO! Drunkard's Path-3½" Finished (55070)
- GO! Funky Flowers (55042)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (55032)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1¾ yards
- Fabric 2—2 yards
- Fabric 3—2¼ yards (includes binding)
- Fabric 4—⅔ yard
- Fabric 5—¼ yard or fat quarter
- Fusible web—1½ yards
- Backing—2⅞ yards
- Batting—51" x 58"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics following manufacturer's instructions for appliqué shapes.

Fabric 1:

- Cut 4—2½" x 56" strips along the lengthwise grain of fabric (LOF) for middle border
- Cut 40—Drunkard's Path arc shapes

Fabric 2:

- Cut 8—3½" x 56" strips along the LOF for inner and outer borders
- Cut 40—Drunkard's Path quarter circle shapes

Fabric 3:

NOTE: Refer to quilt diagram to identify Ribbon Twist shapes.

- Cut 5—2½" strips across the width of the fabric for binding
- Cut 40—Drunkard's Path arc shapes
- Cut 6 mirror image pairs—Ribbon Twist "A" shapes
- Cut 1—Ribbon Twist "A" shape with fabric placed on die wrong side up
- Cut 5—Ribbon Twist "B" shapes with fabric layered on die right side up
- Cut 5—Ribbon Twist "C" shapes with fabric layered on die right side up
- Cut 3—Ribbon Twist "D" shapes with fabric layered on die right side up
- Cut 1—Ribbon Twist "D" shape with fabric placed on die wrong side up
- Cut 2—Ribbon Twist "E" shape with fabric layered on die right side up
- Cut 1—Ribbon Twist "E" shape with fabric placed on die wrong side up

Fabric 4:



- Cut 40—Drunkard's Path quarter circle shapes
- Cut 3—funky flowers
- Cut 2—flower centers

Fabric 5:

- Cut 2—funky flowers
- Cut 3—flower centers

SEWING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Follow construction directions included with GO! Drunkard's Path-3½" Finished (55070).

1. Make 40 Drunkard's Path units using Fabric #1 arcs and Fabric #2 quarter circles as shown. 
2. Make 40 Drunkard's Path units using Fabric #3 arcs and Fabric #4 quarter circles as shown.
3. Combine four units to make 20 Drunkard's Path blocks as shown. 
4. Lay out five rows of four blocks each following quilt diagram.
5. Pin and sew blocks into rows.
6. Pin and sew rows together to complete quilt center.
7. Pin and sew one Fabric #1, 2½" middle border strip between two Fabric #2, 3½" inner and outer border strips. Press seams open.
8. Make four border strip sets.
9. Pin and sew border strip sets to quilt center, following diagram and mitering corners. Press seams toward outer border.
10. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
11. Lay out shapes following quilt diagram.
12. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions.
13. Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
