### GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Rick Rack (55056)
- GO! Circle-2", 3", 5" (55012)
- GO! Daisy (55327)—for  $\frac{3}{4}$ " circle
- GO! Carefree Numbers (55099)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter-5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (55026)

### FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards 108" wide bleached muslin or 2 $\frac{3}{4}$  yards 40" wide fabric
- Fabric 2—1 $\frac{3}{4}$  yards
- Fabric 3—1 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards (includes binding)
- Fabric 4—1 $\frac{1}{2}$  yards
- Appliqué fabrics—use scraps or fat quarters
- Fusible web—4 yards
- Backing—3 $\frac{3}{4}$  yards
- Batting—65" x 65"

### CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Apply fusible web to the wrong side of selected fabrics following manufacturer's instructions for rick rack strips and appliqué shapes.

#### Fabric 1:

- Cut 1—46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square (from 108" wide fabric)
- OR Cut 2—23 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles (from 40" wide fabric)

#### Fabric 2:

- Cut 2—5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 58 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the lengthwise grain of fabric (LOF) for top and bottom outer borders
- Cut 2—5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the LOF for side outer borders
- Cut 1 mirror image pair—46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " narrow rick rack strips along the LOF

#### Fabric 3:

- Cut 1 mirror image pair—46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide rick rack strips along the LOF
- Cut a total of 250"—2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the LOF for binding
- Cut 2—1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the LOF for top and bottom inner borders
- Cut 2—1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips along the LOF for side inner borders

#### Fabric 4:

- Cut 2 mirror image pairs—46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " narrow rick rack strips along the LOF

#### Appliqué fabrics:

- Cut numbers 1 – 10 from various fabrics
- Cut a total of 5—5" circles; 2—3" circles; 28—2" circles; and 57— $\frac{3}{4}$ " circles from various fabrics

### SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Pin and sew two Fabric #1, 23 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together if using 40" wide fabric. Press seam open. Position seam horizontally.
2. Lightly press horizontal and vertical centers in Fabric #1, 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
3. Remove paper backing from appliqué shapes.
4. Lay out circles along horizontal center following quilt diagram.
5. Add Fabric #3 wide rick rack strips. There should be 6" between edges of rick rack.

## SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

6. Continue to add rows of circles, rick rack strips and numbers.
7. Fuse shapes in place following manufacturer's instructions after positioning each row of shapes.
8. Appliqué edges of shapes by hand or machine to complete quilt center.
9. Pin and sew one Fabric #3, 1½" x 46½" inner border strip to each side of quilt center. Press all border seams toward inner border.
10. Pin and sew one Fabric #3, 1½" x 48½" inner border strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
11. Pin and sew one Fabric #2, 5½" x 48½" outer border strip to sides of quilt center.
12. Pin and sew one Fabric #2, 5½" x 58½" outer border strip to top and bottom of quilt center.

## QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
