GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Quarter Square-8" Finished Triangle (55399)
- GO! Half Square-8" Finished Triangle (55400)
- GO! Square-8½" (55058)
- GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55014 or 55017)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (55032)
- GO! Strip Cutter-4½" (55054)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1⅞ yards
- Fabric 2—2 yards (includes binding)
- Fabric 3—⅞ yard
- Fabric 4—1 yard
- Backing—67" x 67"
- Batting—67" x 67"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric 1:

- Cut 6—4½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF) for outer border
- Cut 4—8" finished half square triangles
- Cut 20—8" finished quarter square triangles

Fabric 2:

- Cut 5—3½" strips across the WOF for third border
- Cut 7—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 5—8½" squares
- Cut 4—8" finished half square triangles
- Cut 12—8" finished quarter square triangles

Fabric 3:

- Cut 5—2½" strips across the WOF for second border
- Cut 12—8" finished quarter square triangles

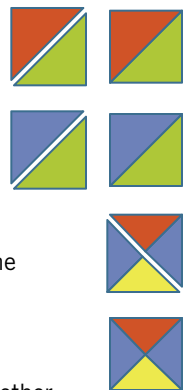
Fabric 4:

- Cut 5—1½" strips across the WOF for first border
- Cut 8—8" finished half square triangles
- Cut 4—8" finished quarter square triangles

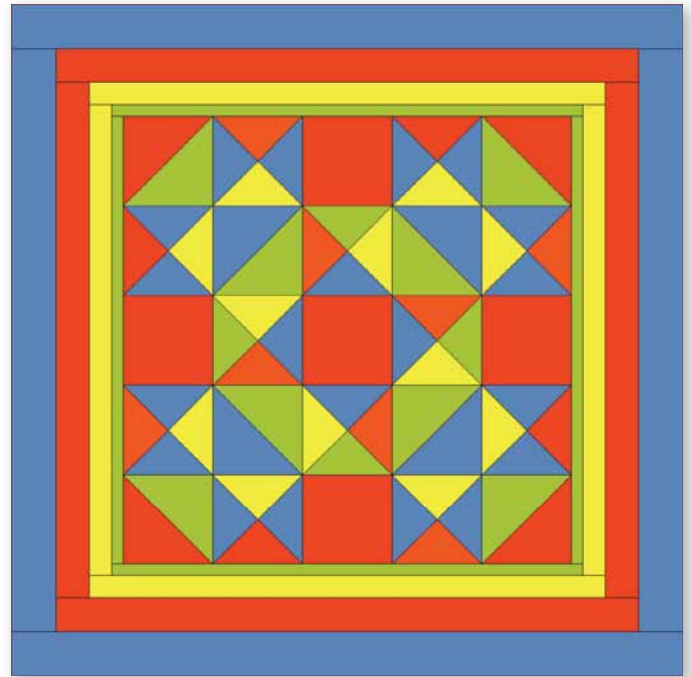
SEWING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Press seams toward the darker fabric or for the least bulk or as directed.

1. Pin and sew one Fabric #2 half square triangle and one Fabric #4 half square triangle together. Make four half square triangle blocks.
2. Pin and sew one Fabric #1 half square triangle and one Fabric #4 half square triangle together. Make four half square triangle blocks.
3. Lay out two Fabric #1, one Fabric #2 and one Fabric #3 quarter square triangles as shown.
4. Pin and sew together to form two combined triangle units.
5. Pin and sew two combined triangle units together to form quarter square triangle block. Make eight quarter square blocks as shown.



6. Lay out one each Fabric #1, #2, #3 and #4 quarter square triangles as shown.
7. Pin and sew together to form two combined triangle units.
8. Pin and sew two combined triangle units together to form quarter square triangle block. Make four quarter square blocks as shown.
9. Lay out five rows of five blocks according to quilt diagram. Pin and sew blocks into rows. Press in opposite direction for each row.
10. Pin and sew rows together. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
11. Add 1½" Fabric #4 first border strips to the sides first, then top and bottom of quilt center piecing border strips where necessary. Press seams toward first border.
12. Add 2½" Fabric #3 second border strips to the sides first, then top and bottom of quilt center piecing border strips where necessary. Press seams toward second border.
13. Add 3½" Fabric #2 third border strips to the sides first, then top and bottom of quilt center piecing border strips where necessary. Press seams toward third border.
14. Add 4½" Fabric #1 outer border strips to the sides first, then top and bottom of quilt center piecing border strips where necessary. Press seams toward third border.



QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add Fabric #2 binding strips, mitering corners.
