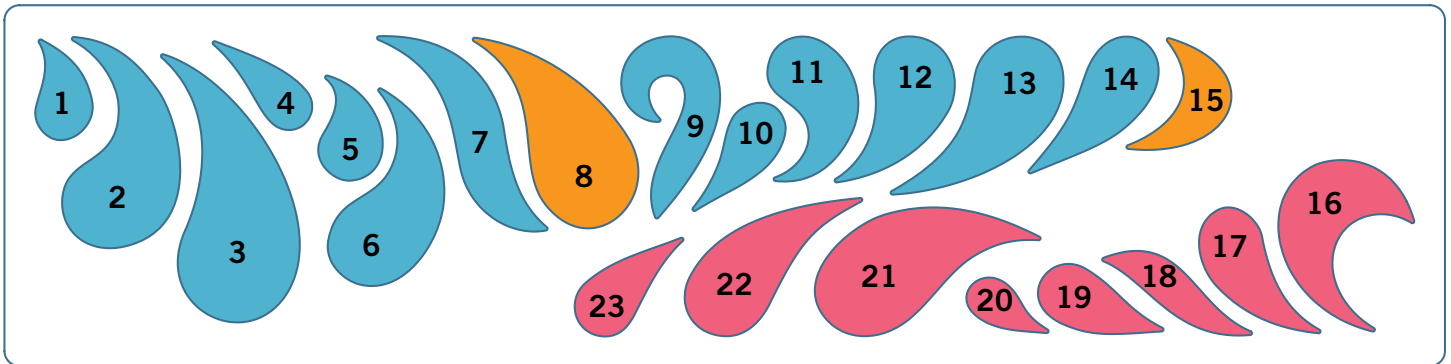


## GO! Heather Feather Border Collection

finished border sizes 32", 48", 64" or 80"

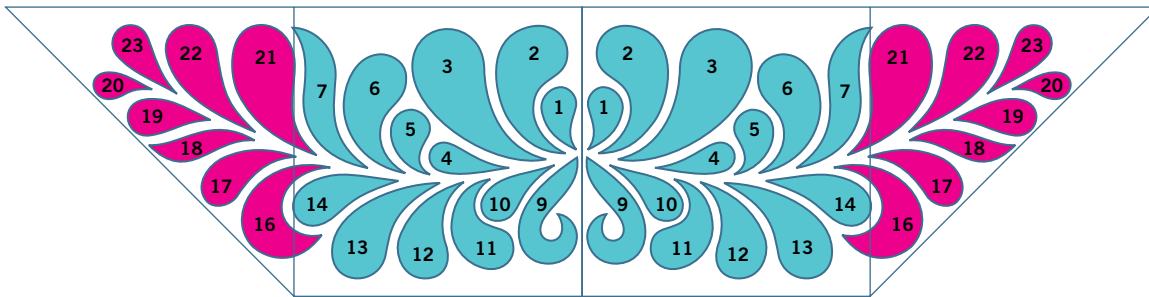
The GO!® Heather Feather Border Collection die was designed to allow the creation of an 8" wide feathered border with an 8" repeat and a mitered corner. The following instructions specify how to create borders with 1 repeat in each half of the border, 2 repeats, 3 repeats and 4 repeats.

**NOTE:** Apply fusible web product to wrong side of selected fabrics, following manufacturer's instructions, before cutting for fusible appliqué.

### BORDER WITH 1 REPEAT, FINISHED SIZE 32"

For each border you will need:

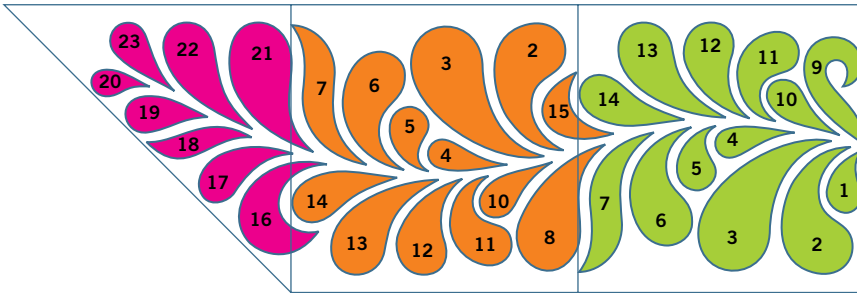
- 1—32½" x 8½" piece of background fabric
  - 2—24" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing
- Place one piece of fabric right side up on the die board, the other piece right side down. (Cover all pieces on the die board. You will discard pieces 8 and 15.)



### BORDER WITH 2 REPEATS, FINISHED SIZE 48" (See diagram on page #2)

For each border you will need:

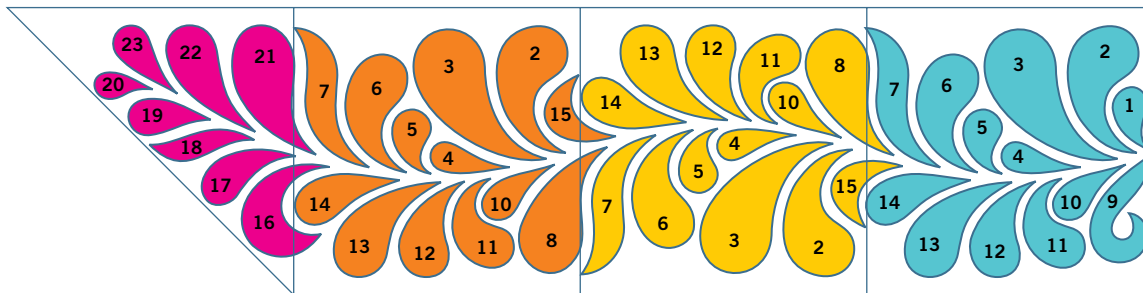
- 1—48½" x 8½" piece of background fabric
  - 2—24" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing
- Place one piece of fabric right side up on the die board, the other piece right side down. (Cover all pieces on the die board. You will discard pieces 8 and 15. The pieces used are shown in green and pink in the diagram.)
- 2—20" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing
- Place one piece of fabric right side up on the die board, the other piece right side down. (Cover pieces 1-14 on the die board. You will discard pieces 1, 9 and 18-23. The pieces used are shown in orange in the diagram.)



### BORDER WITH 3 REPEATS, FINISHED SIZE 64"

For each border you will need:

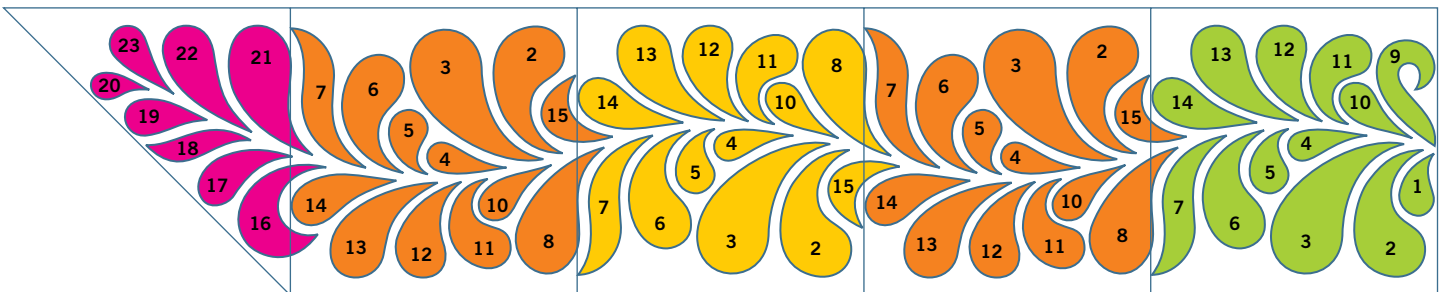
- 1—64½" x 8½" piece of background fabric
- 2—24" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing  
Place one piece of fabric right side up on the die board, the other piece right side down. (Cover all pieces on the die board. You will discard pieces 8 and 15. The pieces used are shown in blue and pink in the diagram.)
- 4—20" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing  
Place two pieces of fabric right side up on the die board, the other two right side down. (Cover pieces 1-14 on the die board. You will discard pieces 1, 9 and 18-23. The pieces used are shown in orange and yellow in the diagram.)



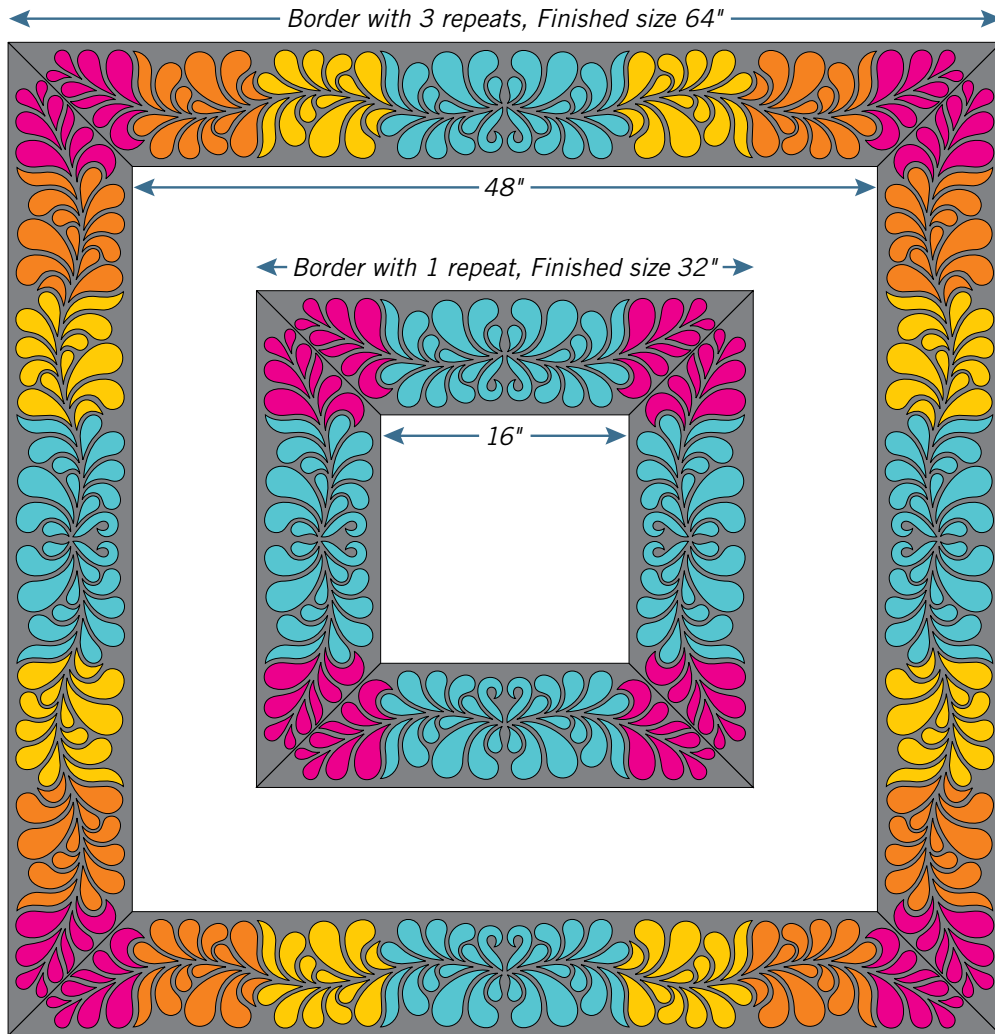
### BORDER WITH 4 REPEATS, FINISHED SIZE 80"

For each border you will need:

- 1—80½" x 8½" piece of background fabric
- 2—24" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing  
Place one piece of fabric right side up on the die board, the other piece right side down. (Cover all pieces on the die board. You will discard pieces 8 and 15. The pieces used are shown in green and pink in the diagram.)
- 6—20" x 6" pieces of appliqué fabric backed with fusible webbing  
Place three pieces of fabric right side up on the die board, the other three right side down. (Cover pieces 1-14 on the die board. You will discard pieces 1, 9 and 18-23. The pieces used are shown in orange and yellow in the diagram.)

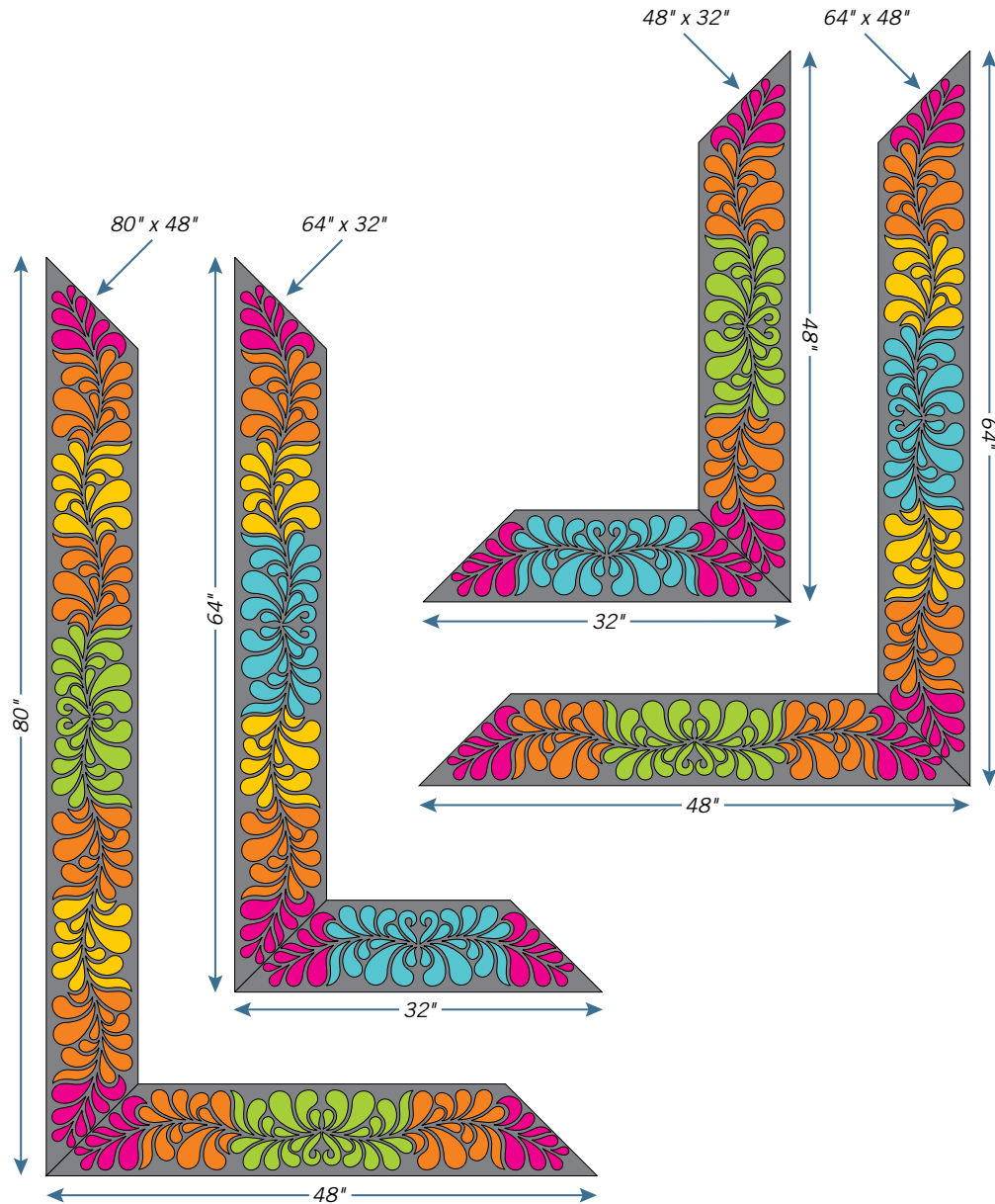

## TO LAY OUT YOUR APPLIQUÉ PIECES

**TIP:** Use your favorite fabric marking pen or pencil to mark a spine on your background fabric as shown. Make sure that the markings you make can be removed.

- With the border going lengthwise from left to right, mark a vertical center line and a horizontal center line.
- Mark 8" increments from the vertical center to the end of each side of the border.
- Trace the template provided (Heather Feather Border Spine) between each pair of vertical lines.
- Position the appliqué shapes so that the point of each shape rests on the outside edge of the spine. Fuse the shapes in place when you are satisfied with the positioning.

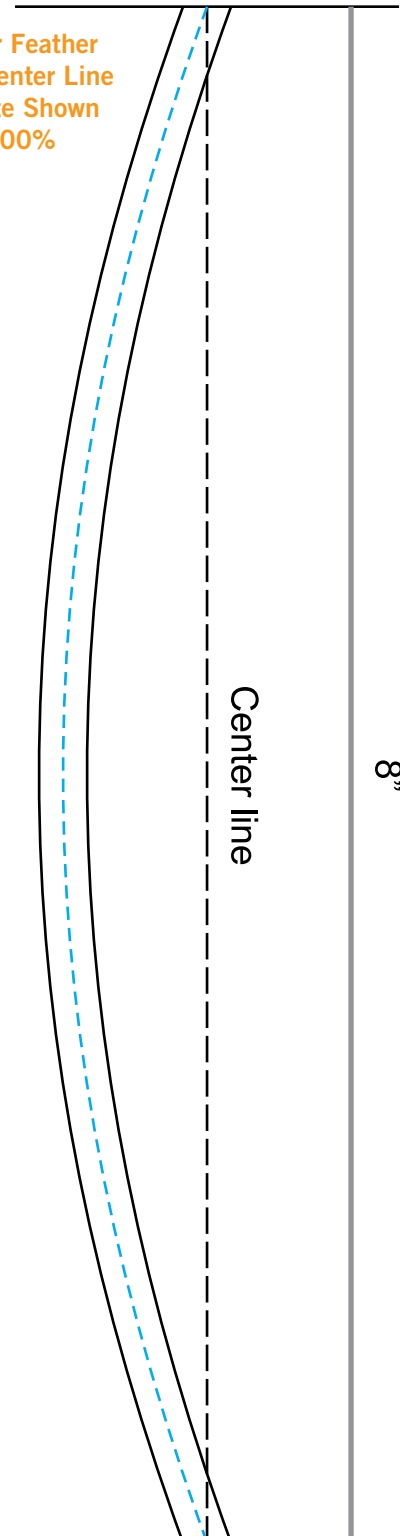
