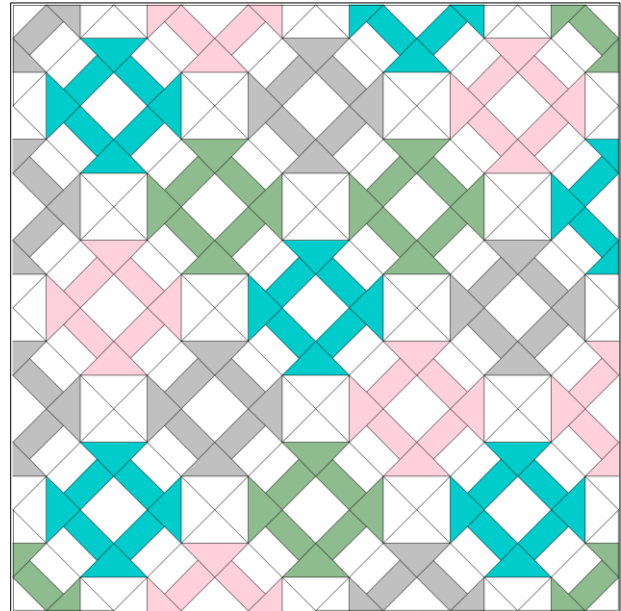


GO! Churn Dash Baby Quilt

GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements

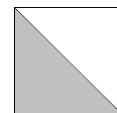
Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
White	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 7—10 ³ / ₄ " x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 9 ¹ / ₂ " widths. Cut 100 half square triangles (HST) and 100 rectangles.	2 ³ / ₄ yards
White	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 4—5" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5" widths. Cut 25 squares.	Yardage included above
Grey	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 2—10 ³ / ₄ " x WOF strips. Fanfold into 9 ¹ / ₂ " widths. Cut 28 HST's and 28 rectangles.	3/4 yard
Pink	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 2—10 ³ / ₄ " x WOF strips. Fanfold into 9 ¹ / ₂ " widths. Cut 24 HST's and 24 rectangles.	3/4 yard
Teal	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 2—10 ³ / ₄ " x WOF strips. Fanfold into 9 ¹ / ₂ " widths. Cut 24 HST's and 24 rectangles.	3/4 yard
Green	GO! Big Churn Dash-12" Finished (55459)	Cut 2—10 ³ / ₄ " x WOF strips. Fanfold into 9 ¹ / ₂ " widths. Cut 24 HST's and 24 rectangles.	3/4 yard

Additional Fabrics Needed

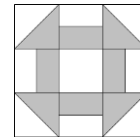
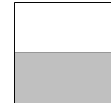
- Binding—2/3 yard
- Backing—4 yards
- Batting—61" x 61"

Sewing Directions

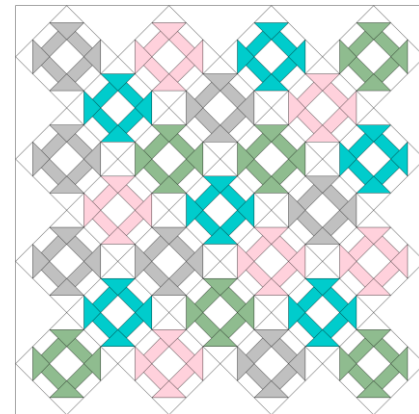
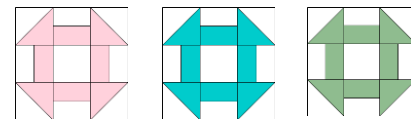
1. Lay out one white half square triangle (HST) and one grey HST.
2. Pin and sew triangles together to make one grey HST.
3. Repeat previous two steps to make a total of four grey HST's. Block should measure 4¹/₂"W x 4¹/₂"H.



4. Lay out one white rectangle and one grey rectangle.
5. Pin and sew rectangles together to make one grey connector square. Block should measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ "W x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "H.
6. Repeat previous two steps to make a total of four grey connector squares.
7. Lay out four grey HST's, four grey connector squares and one white square as shown.
8. Pin and sew blocks into rows.
9. Pin and sew rows together to make one complete grey Churn Dash block.
10. Repeat all previous steps to make a total of seven grey Churn Dash blocks, six pink Churn Dash blocks, six teal churn Dash blocks and six green Churn Dash blocks.



11. Lay out blocks in diagonal rows as shown in the picture.
12. Pin and sew blocks together into diagonal rows.
13. Pin and sew diagonal rows together to make the quilt top.
14. Trim blocks even along the edges as shown.



Quilting & Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
