


GO! Quatrefoil Squared Quilt

GO!® Dies Used, Number of Shapes to Cut & Fabric Requirements





Fabric Color	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
White	GO! Big Square-10" (9½" Finished) (55451)	Cut 9—10½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 10½" widths. Sub cut 27—10" squares.	3 ¾ yards
White	GO! Square-5" (4½" Finished) (55010)	Cut 6—5½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5½" widths. Cut 36—5" squares.	Yardage included above
Assorted Orange	GO! Big Circle-4", 6", 7", 8" (55462)	Cut 2—8½" x WOF strips. (Apply fusible web to the wrong side prior to cutting following the manufacturer's instructions) Sub cut 8—8" circles. Pre-fuse 2—6½" squares to cut 2—6" circles.	1 yard total
Assorted Green	GO! Big Circle-4", 6", 7", 8" (55462)	Cut 2—8½" x WOF strips. (Apply fusible web to the wrong side prior to cutting following the manufacturer's instructions) Sub cut 5—8" circles and use remainder of 8½" x WOF strip to cut 2—6" circles.	¾ yard total
Assorted Yellow	GO! Big Circle-4", 6", 7", 8" (55462)	Cut 3—8½" x WOF strips. (Apply fusible web to the wrong side prior to cutting following the manufacturer's instructions) Sub cut 10—8" circles and use remainder of 8½" x WOF strip to cut 4—6" circles.	1 yard total
Assorted Blue	GO! Big Circle-4", 6", 7", 8" (55462)	Cut 1—8½" x WOF strip. (Apply fusible web to the wrong side prior to cutting following the manufacturer's instructions) Sub cut 4—8" circles. Pre-fuse 1—6½" square to cut 1—6" circle.	⅔ yard total

Additional Fabrics Needed

- Fusible Web—4¼ yards (20" WOF)
- Binding—1/2 yard
- Backing— 3 1/3 yards
- Batting—58" x 70"

Sewing Directions

1. Lay out one white 10" square, one blue 8" circle and one orange 6" circle as shown.
2. Fuse circles in place and stitch in place using a small zigzag or decorative stitch on your machine.
3. Repeat previous two steps to make two center squares.
4. Lay out one white 10" square and one orange 8" circle as shown.
5. Fuse circle in place and stitch in place using a small zigzag or decorative stitch on your machine.
6. Cut the 10" appliquéd orange circle square created in step #5 in half to make two 10"W x 5"H half circle rectangles.
7. Repeat previous two steps to make a total of eight 10"W x 5"H half circle rectangles.
8. Lay out one center square, four half circle rectangles and four white 5" squares as shown.
9. Sew blocks into rows pressing seams in opposite directions.
10. Sew rows together to make one orange block. Press seams in same direction. Block should measure 19".
11. Repeat previous three steps to make a total of two orange blocks.
12. Repeat previous 11 steps to make a total of two green blocks, one blue block and four yellow blocks following the coloring in the diagram.
13. Lay out the blocks as shown in the diagram.
14. Sew blocks into rows pressing seams in opposite directions.
15. Sew rows together to make quilt top. Pressing seams in the same direction.



Quilting & Finishing

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was custom machine quilted.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
