

Bright Blue	 4	GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4" Finished Square (55711)	Cut 4—5¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5¾" widths. Sub cut into 84—4" finished quarter square triangles	Yardage included above
Bright Blue	 5	GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (55712)	Cut 4—3½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 84—2" finished half square triangles	Yardage included above
Gray Print	 5	GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (55712)	Cut 7—3½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 168—2" finished half square triangles	1½ yards



White		2 GO! Square-2 1/2" (2" Finished) (55709)	Cut 3—5 1/2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 5 1/2" widths. Sub cut into 84—2 1/2" squares	2 1/2 yards
White		4 GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4" Finished Square (55711)	Cut 4—5 3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5 3/4" widths. Sub cut into 84—4" finished quarter square triangles	Yardage included above
White		5 GO! Half Square Triangle-2" Finished Square (55712)	Cut 10—3 1/2" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 252—2" finished half square triangles	Yardage included above
White		6 GO! Square on Point-3 1/4" (2 3/4" Finished) (55713)	Cut 3—3 3/4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3 3/4" widths. Sub cut into 21—3 1/4" squares on point	Yardage included above

Additional Fabrics Needed:


- Backing Fabric—54" x 62"
- Batting—54" x 62"

Sewing Directions:

1. Lay out four bright blue 2" finished half square triangles (HSTs) and one white 3 1/4" square on point.



2. Pin and sew one bright blue 2" finished HST to each side of one white 3¼" square on point to create a square in square unit as shown. Press seams toward the bright blue HSTs. Make 21 units.




3. Lay out two white 2" finished HST and one bright blue 4" finished quarter square triangle (QST).



4. Pin and sew one white 2" finished HST on either side of the bright blue 4" finished QST to form a flying geese unit as shown. Press seams toward white HSTs. Make 84 units.




5. Lay out four bright blue 2½" squares, four flying geese units, and one square in a square unit to create a GO! Diamond Star Block as shown.




6. Pin and sew three rows. Press seams away from the flying geese units.

7. Pin and sew three row units together to form one block. Press seams toward the center row. Make 21 blocks.



8. Lay out four white 2" finished HSTs and one gray print 3¼" square on point.

9. Pin and sew one white 2" finished HST to each side of one gray print 3¼" square on point to create a square in square unit as shown. Press seams toward the white HSTs. Make 21 units.






10. Lay out two gray print 2" finished HST and one white 4" finished QST.



11. Pin and sew one gray print 2" finished HST on either side of the white 4" finished QST to form a flying geese unit as shown. Press seams toward white HSTs. Make 84 units.



12. Lay out four white 2½" squares, four flying geese units, and one square in a square unit to create a GO! Diamond Star Block as shown.
13. Pin and sew three rows. Press seams toward the flying geese units.
14. Pin and sew three row units together to form one block. Press seams away from the center row.
15. Lay out alternating blocks in 7 rows of six using the quilt diagram as a reference.
16. Pin and sew 7 rows. Press seams in alternating directions for each row.
17. Pin and sew 7 row units together. Press seams toward the added rows.




Quilting and Finishing:


1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add gray print fabric binding, mitering corners.

Additional Size Options:

- For a full size quilt measuring 88" x 88" make a total of 121 quilt blocks - 61 bright blue/white and 60 gray print/white. Lay out alternating blocks in 11 rows of 11 using the first diagram below as a reference.
- For a king size quilt measuring 104" x 96" make a total of 156 quilt blocks - 78 bright blue/white and 78 gray print/white. Lay out alternating blocks in 12 rows of 13 using the second diagram below as a reference.
