Bright Blue	 5	GO! Half Square Triangle-2¼" Finished Square (55719)	Cut 3—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3¼" widths. Sub cut into 72—2¼" finished half square triangles	Yardage included above
Gray Print	 5	GO! Half Square Triangle-2¼" Finished Square (55719)	Cut 6—3¾" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3¼" widths. Sub cut into 136—2¼" finished half square triangles	1½ yards



Additional Fabrics Needed:


- Backing Fabric—51" x 69"
- Batting—51" x 69"

Sewing Directions:

1. Lay out four bright blue 2¹/₄" finished half square triangles (HSTs) and one white 3¹¹/₁₆" square on point.




2. Pin and sew one bright blue 2¼" finished HST to each side of one white 3¹¹/₁₆" square on point to create a square in square unit as shown. Press seams toward the bright blue HSTs. Make 18 units.




3. Lay out two white 2¼" finished HST and one bright blue 4½" finished quarter square triangle (QST).



4. Pin and sew one white 2¼" finished HST on either side of the bright blue 4½" finished QST to form a flying geese unit as shown. Press seams toward white HSTs. Make 72 units.




5. Lay out four bright blue 2¾" squares, four flying geese units, and one square in a square unit to create a GO! Diamond Star Block as shown.




6. Pin and sew three rows. Press seams away from the flying geese units.

7. Pin and sew three row units together to form one block. Press seams toward the center row. Make 18 blocks.




8. Lay out four white 2¼" finished HSTs and one gray print 3¹¹/₁₆" square on point.

9. Pin and sew one white 2¼" finished HST to each side of one gray print 3¹¹/₁₆" square on point to create a square in square unit as shown. Press seams toward the white HSTs. Make 17 units.









10. Lay out two gray print 2¼" finished HST and one white 4½" finished QST.



11. Pin and sew one gray print 2¼" finished HST on either side of the white 4½" finished QST to form a flying geese unit as shown. Press seams toward white HSTs. Make 68 units.



12. Lay out four white 2¾" squares, four flying geese units, and one square in a square unit to create a GO! Diamond Star Block as shown.
13. Pin and sew three rows. Press seams toward the flying geese units.
14. Pin and sew three row units together to form one block. Press seams away from the center row.
15. Lay out alternating blocks in seven rows of five using the quilt diagram as a reference.
16. Pin and sew seven rows. Press seams in alternating directions for each row.
17. Pin and sew seven row units together. Press seams toward the added rows.




Quilting and Finishing:


1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add gray print fabric binding, mitering corners.

Additional Size Options:

- For a full size quilt measuring 81" x 90" make a total of 90 quilt blocks - 45 bright blue/white and 45 gray print/white. Lay out alternating blocks in 10 rows of 9 using the first diagram below as a reference.
- For a king size quilt measuring 108" x 99" make a total of 132 quilt blocks - 66 bright blue/white and 66 gray print/white. Lay out alternating blocks in 11 rows of 12 using the second diagram below as a reference.
