Fabric Color	Shape & #	GO! Dies Used	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Pink	 8	GO! Rectangle-3½" x 6½" (3" x 6" Finished) (55724)	Cut 4—7" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 7½" widths. Sub cut into 40—3½" x 6½" rectangles	1 yard
Purple	 9	GO! Chisels-3" x 6" Finished (55736)	Cut 40—7" x 4" rectangles. Place fabric wrong side up over the chisel shape and sub cut into 40—chisels	1⅓ yards
Purple	 2	GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)	Cut 6—2½" x WOF strips for binding	Yardage included above
Teal	 5	GO! Half Square Triangle- 3" Finished Square (55703)	Cut 3—4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4¾" widths. Sub cut into 40—3" finished half square triangles	1¼ yards
Teal	 8	GO! Rectangle-3½" x 6½" (3" x 6" Finished) (55724)	Cut 4—7" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 7½" widths. Sub cut into 40—3½" x 6½" rectangles	Yardage included above

White		8	GO! Rectangle-3½" x 6½" (3" x 6" Finished) (55724)	Cut 4—7" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 7½" widths. Sub cut into 40—3½" x 6½" rectangles	1 yard
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Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Backing Fabric—54" x 66"
- Batting—54" x 66"

Sewing Directions:

1. Pin and sew one teal 3" finished half square triangle (HST) and one purple 3" x 6" finished chisel together as shown. Press seam toward the teal triangle. Make 40 purple chisel units.




2. Pin and sew one white 3" x 6" finished rectangle and one purple chisel unit together as shown. Press seam toward the white rectangle. Make 40 white rectangle quarter block units.



3. Pin and sew one pink 3" x 6" finished rectangle and one teal 3" x 6" finished rectangle together as shown. Press seam toward the teal rectangle. Make 40 pink rectangle quarter block units.




4. Lay out two white rectangle quarter block units and two pink rectangle quarter block units as shown.




5. Pin and sew into half blocks. Press seams toward pink rectangle quarter block units. Make two half blocks.

6. Pin and sew half blocks together to complete the block. Press seam open. Make 20 blocks.




7. Lay out blocks in five rows of four using the quilt diagram as a reference.
8. Pin and sew five rows. Press seams in alternating directions for each row.
9. Pin and sew five row units together. Press seams toward the added rows.




Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add purple fabric binding, mitering corners.




Additional Size Options:

- For a full size quilt measuring 84" x 96" make a total of 56 quilt blocks. Lay out blocks in eight rows of seven using the first diagram below as a reference.
- For a king size quilt measuring 108" x 96" make a total of 72 quilt blocks. Lay out blocks in eight rows of nine using the second diagram below as a reference.
