

To make a 12" Block use GO! Qube Mix & Match 12" Block (55778)






- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (Shape 4)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Square on Point-4¾" (4¼" Finished) (Shape 6)

### Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55053)

### Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Shape & #	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Light Blue		Cut 2, 4¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4" widths and cut 36 half square triangles (HSTs).	1/2 yard
Dark Blue		Cut 2, 7¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 7¾" widths and cut 36 quarter square triangles (QST).	5/8 yard

Fabric Color	Shape & #	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Light Green		Cut 2, 7¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 7¾" widths and cut 30 QSTs.	1 1/8 yards
Light Green		Cut 4, 4¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4" widths and cut 72 HSTs.	Yardage included above
Dark Green		Cut 1, 7¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 7¾" widths and cut 18 quarter square triangles (QST).	1 yard
Dark Green		Cut 2, 4¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4" widths and cut 24 HSTs.	Yardage included above
White		Cut 2, 5¼" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 5¼" widths and cut 9 squares on point.	1/2 yard

**Additional Cutting Directions:**

- Binding
  - Cut approximately 180" of 2¼" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55053) for binding

**Additional Fabrics Needed:**

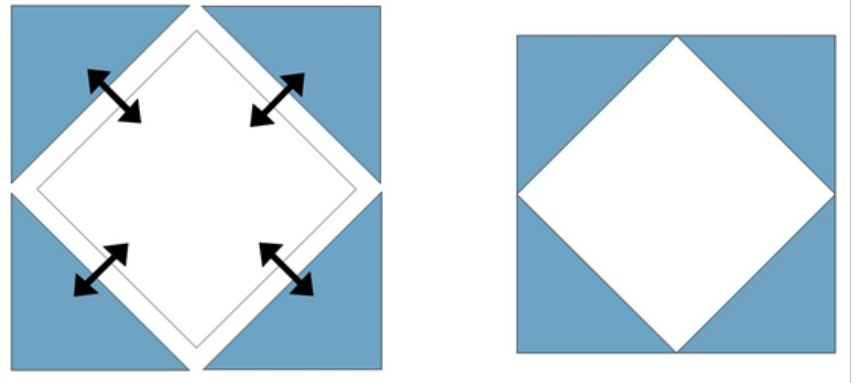
- Binding: Dark Green Fabric—Yardage included above
- Backing: 42" x 48"
- Batting: 42" x 48"

**Sewing Directions:**

*Press all seams open and use 1/4" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

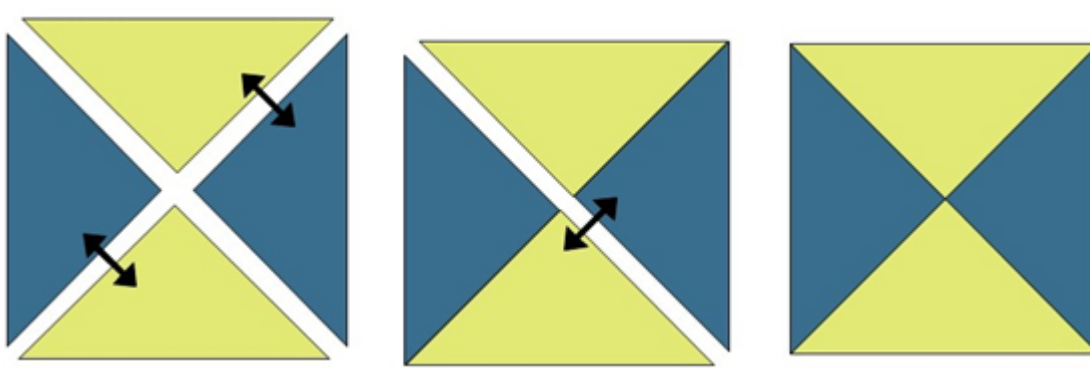
**Square in a Square Block**

1. Sew a light blue half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) onto each side of a white square on point (Shape 6). Press seams towards the light blue fabric. Make a total of 9 Square in a Square Blocks.



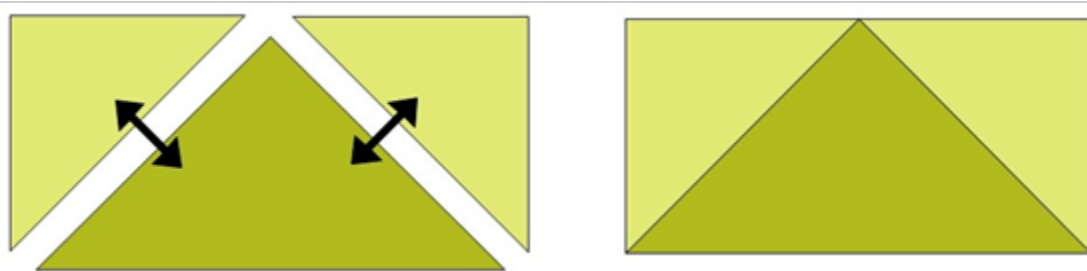
**Hour Glass Block**

1. Sew two dark blue quarter square triangles (QST) (Shape 4) with two light green QST's (Shape 4) as shown. Make a total of 9 Hour Glass Blocks.

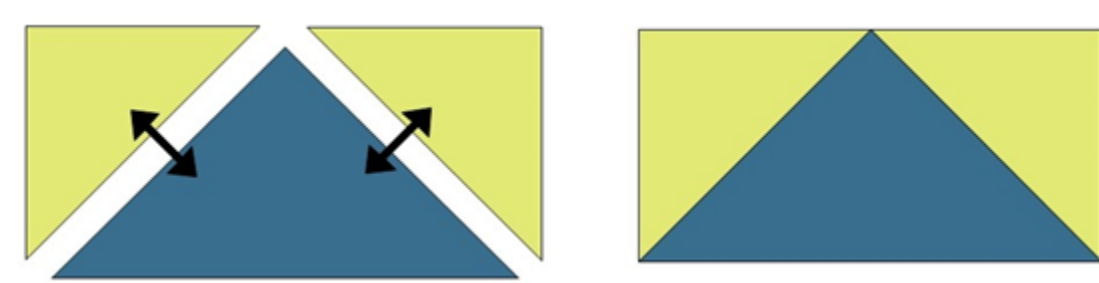


## Flying Geese Units

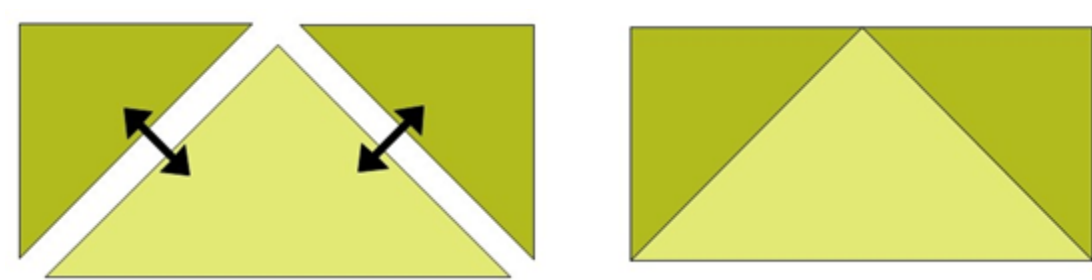
1. Sew a light green HST (Shape 5) onto both short edges of a dark green QST (Shape 4). Press seams towards the light green fabric. Make a total of 18 Light Green/Dark Green Flying Geese units.



2. Sew a light green HST (Shape 5) onto both short edges of a dark blue QST (Shape 4). Press seams towards the light green fabric. Make a total of 18 Light Green/Dark Blue Flying Geese Units.



3. Sew a dark green HST (Shape 5) onto both short edges of a light green QST (Shape 4). Press seams towards the light green fabric. Make a total of 12 Dark Green/Light Green Flying Geese Units.



### Assemble the Quilt Top

1. Lay out 9 Square in a Square Blocks, 9 Hour Glass Blocks, 18 Light Green/Dark Green Flying Geese Units, 18 Light Green/Dark Blue Flying Geese Units and 12 Dark Green/Light Green Flying Geese Units as shown.
2. Sew units within each column together then sew columns together to complete the quilt.



**Quilting and Finishing:**

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
