

To make a 9" Block use GO! Qube Mix & Match 9" Block (55777)



- GO! Half Square Triangle-4½" Finished Square (Shape 3)
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-4½" Finished Square (Shape 4)

Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55053)

Cutting Directions:

Fabric Color	Shape & #	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
White	 3	Cut 16, 5¾" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 5¾" widths and cut 192 half square triangles (HSTs).	5 yards
White	 4	Cut 16, 5½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 3¼" widths and cut 192 quarter square triangles (QST).	Yardage included above

Fabric Color	Shape & #	Number of Shapes to Cut	Fabric Required
Orange		Cut 8, 5½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 3¼" widths and cut 96 QSTs.	1 ¼ yards
Pink		Cut 8, 5½" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 3¼" widths and cut 96 QSTs.	1 ¾ yard

Additional Cutting Directions:

- Binding
 - Cut 7—2¼" strips of pink fabric using GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55053) for binding—Yardage included above

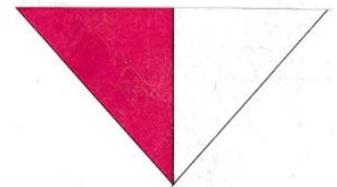
Additional Fabrics Needed:

- Backing: 62½" x 80½"
- Batting: 62½" x 80½"

Sewing Directions:

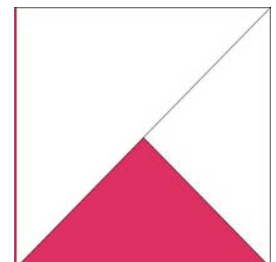
Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.

1. Sew one white quarter square triangle (QST) (Shape 4) and one pink QST (Shape 4) together as shown. Press seams towards the pink fabric. Make a total of 96 white and pink QST units.

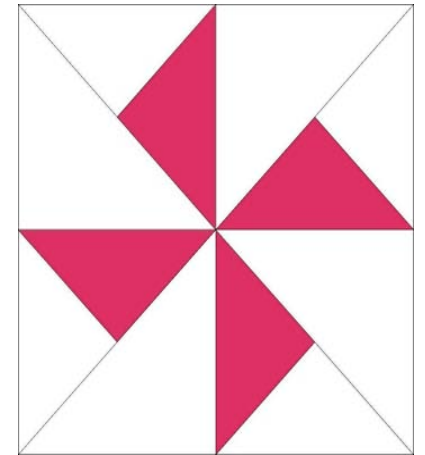
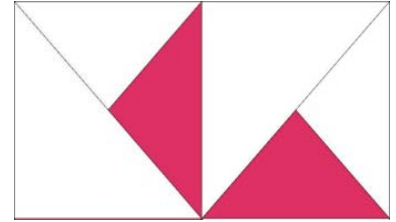


2. Repeat Step 1 using one white QST (Shape 4) and one orange QST (Shape 4) to make a total of 96 white and orange QST units. Press seams towards the orange fabric.

3. Sew one white half square triangle (HST) (Shape 3) to each of the units from Step 1 and Step 2 making a total of 196 units. There will be 96 pink units and 96 orange units as shown.

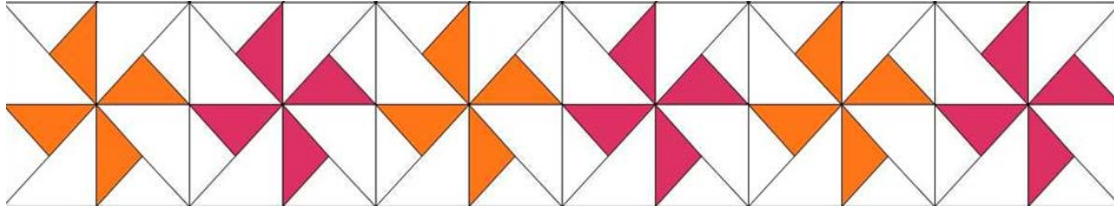


4. Join two pink units from Step 3 together and press. Make a total of 48 units as shown.
5. Repeat Step 4 using the orange units from Step 3 to make a total of 48 orange units.
6. Join two pink units from Step 4 together to make one finished pink block as shown. Make 24 blocks.
7. Repeat Step 6 using orange units from Step 5 to make 24 finished orange blocks.

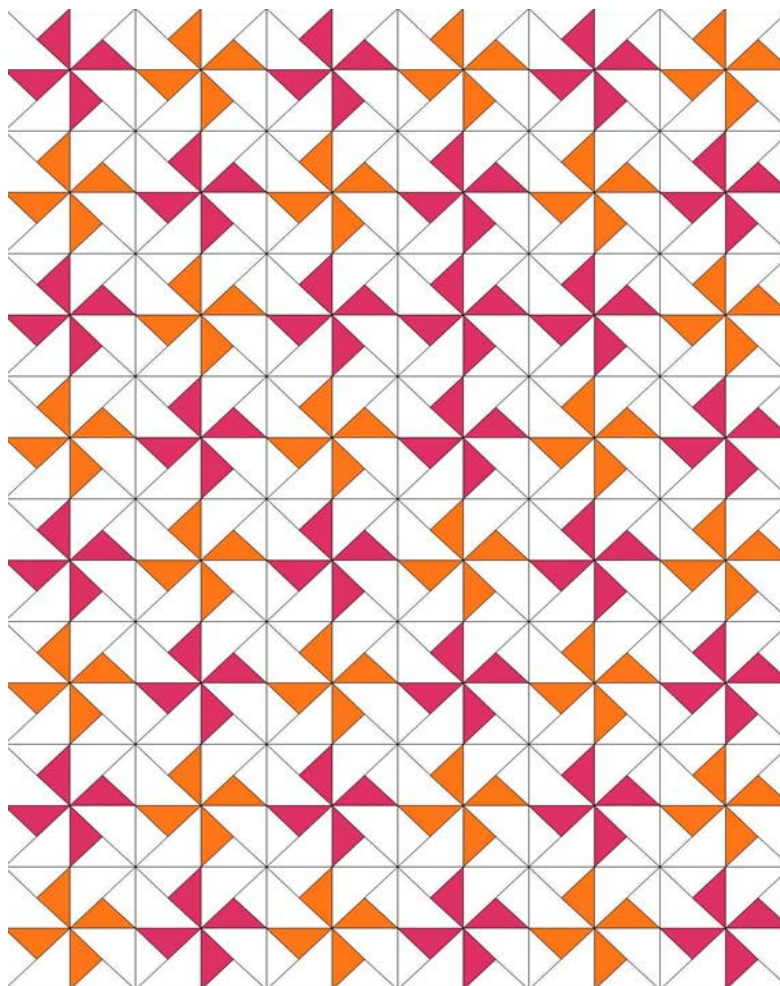


Assemble the Quilt Top:

1. Referring to the quilt assembly diagram, lay out all the blocks into 8 rows of 6 blocks. Sew the blocks together alternating each row so one starts with pink and the next with orange. Press the seams in opposite directions on alternating rows.



2. Matching the block seams, sew the rows together.



Quilting and Finishing:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Attach bias binding, mitering the corners.
