### Dies Needed:

#### GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

- GO! Square-3½" (3" Finished) (Shape 1)
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (Shape 4)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-1½" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Rectangle-2" x 3½" (1½" x 3" Finished) (Shape 8)

















- GO! Chisels-1½" x 3" Finished (Shape 9)
- GO! Signature Block-3" Finished (Shape 10)
- GO! Drunkard's Path-Arc Shape-3" Finished (Shape 11)
- GO! Drunkard's Path-Quarter Circle-3" Finished (Shape 12)

### Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)

**Cutting Directions:**

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Large Flowers-Yellow (A)		Cut 5—5" squares. Sub cut into 18—3" finished quarter square triangles (QSTs).	1/4 yard
Mini Flowers-Pink (B)		Cut 3—4" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 36—1½" x 3" finished rectangles.	1/2 yard
Large Flowers-Blue (C)		Cut 3—3" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 36—quarter circles.	3/8 yard
Medium Flowers-Green (D)		Cut 3—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 36—1½" x 3" finished rectangles.	1 1/8 yards
Medium Flowers-Green (D)		Cut 4—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 36—signature blocks.	Yardage included above
Mini Flowers-Purple (E)		Cut 1—5¼" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 36—1½" finished half square triangles (HSTs).	3/4 yard
Mini Flowers-Purple (E)		Cut 3—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 36—1½" x 3" finished rectangles.	Yardage included above
Medium Flowers-Blue (F)		Cut 5—5" squares. Sub cut into 18—3" finished QSTs.	1/4 yard
Large Flowers-Purple (G)		Cut 24—6¼" x 2½" strips. Layer up to 6 layers of fabric <i>right side down</i> on die and cut 48—"right" chisels. Shift the strip to cut the next "right" chisels. Do not fanfold.	1/2 yard

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Mini Flowers- Yellow (H)		Cut 24—6¼" x 2½" strips. Layer up to 6 layers of fabric <i>right side up</i> on die and cut 48—"left" chisels. Shift the strip to cut the next "left" chisels. Do not fanfold.	1/2 yard
Dots- Blue & White (J)		Cut 3—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 24—3" finished squares.	2-2/3 yards
Dots- Blue & White (J)		Cut 9—5" squares. Sub cut into 36—3" finished QSTs.	Yardage included above
Dots- Blue & White (J)		Cut 3—5¼" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 132—1½" finished HSTs.	Yardage included above
Dots- Blue & White (J)		Cut 3—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 36—1½" x 3" finished rectangles.	Yardage included above
Dots- Blue & White (J)		Cut 4—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 36—arc shapes.	Yardage included above
Dots- Blue & White (J)	GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032)	Cut 6—3½" x WOF strips. Sew strips together with diagonal seams and cut 2—3½" x 54½" strips and 2—3½" x 57½" strips.	Yardage included above

### Additional Cutting Instructions:

- Blue Plaid (I): 1-2/3 yards
  - Cut 6—1½" strips x 54½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024).
  - Cut 2—2" x 54½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025).
  - Cut 2—2" x 48½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025).

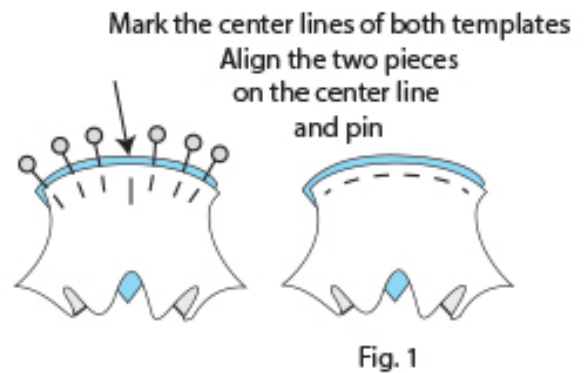
**Additional Fabrics Needed:**

- Binding: ½ yard
  - Cut 6—2½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) for binding.
- Batting: 62" x 71"
- Backing: 3½ yards cut into 2—62" pieces. Sew the pieces together along the 62" length to make the backing.

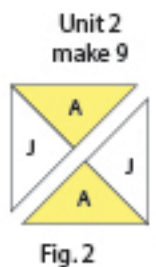
**Sewing Directions:**

*Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

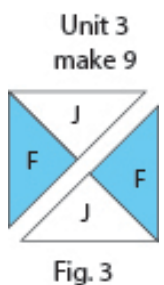
1. Align the Fabric C quarter circle (Shape 12) and Fabric J arc shape (Shape 11) right sides together, matching the center mark on each piece. Pin the two pieces together at the center mark and then at each end. Carefully sew the two pieces together using a ¼" seam. Flip open the sewn unit and press to make 1—Unit 1 as shown in Figure 1. Repeat to make 36—Unit 1 blocks total.



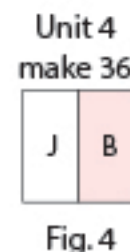
2. Sew together two Fabric A 3" finished quarter square triangles (QSTs) (Shape 4) and two Fabric J 3" finished QSTs (Shape 4) to make 1—Unit 2 as shown in Figure 2. Repeat to make 9—Unit 2 blocks total.



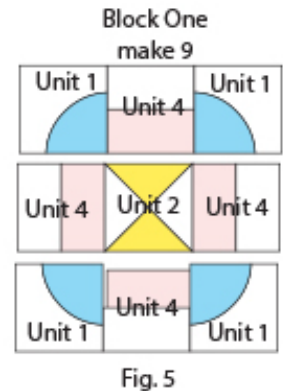
3. Sew together two Fabric F 3" finished QSTs (Shape 4) and two Fabric J 3" finished QSTs (Shape 4) to make 1—Unit 3 as shown in Figure 3. Repeat to make 9—Unit 3 blocks total.



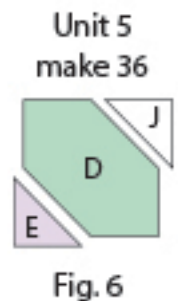
4. Sew one Fabric J and one Fabric B 1½" x 3" finished rectangle (Shape 8) together to make 1—Unit 4 as shown in Figure 4. Repeat to make 36—Unit 4 blocks total.



5. Sew together 2—Unit 1 blocks and 1—Unit 4 block to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew together 2—Unit 4 blocks and 1—Unit 2 block to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make 1—9½" Block One as shown in Figure 5. Repeat to make 9—Block One squares total.



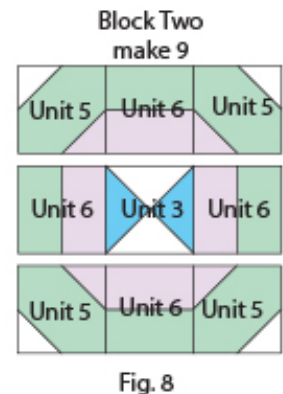
6. Sew one Fabric J 1½" finished half square triangle (HST) (Shape 5) to the upper right corner of one Fabric D signature block (Shape 10). Sew one Fabric E 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to the lower left corner of the Fabric D signature block (Shape 10) to make 1—Unit 5 as shown in Figure 6. Repeat to make 36—Unit 5 blocks total.



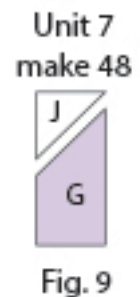
7. Sew together one Fabric D and one Fabric E rectangle (Shape 8) to make 1—Unit 6 as shown in Figure 7. Repeat to make 36—Unit 6 blocks total.



8. Sew together 2—Unit 5 blocks and 1—Unit 6 block to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew together 2—Unit 6 blocks and 1—Unit 3 block to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make 1—9½" Block Two squares as shown in Figure 8. Repeat to make 9—Block Two squares total.



9. Sew one Fabric J 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to the upper left corner of one Fabric G chisel (Shape 9) to make 1—Unit 7 strip as shown in Figure 9. Repeat to make 48—Unit 7 strips total.



10. Sew one Fabric J 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to the upper right corner of one Fabric H chisel (Shape 9) to make 1—Unit 8 strip as shown in Figure 10. Repeat to make 48—Unit 8 strips total.



11. Sew together 1—Unit 7 strip and 1—Unit 8 strip to make 1—Unit 9 block as shown in Figure 11. Repeat to make 48—Unit 9 blocks total.

12. Sew 1—Unit 9 block to the top of one Fabric J  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " finished square (Shape 1). Sew 1—Unit 9 square to the bottom of the Fabric J square to make 1— $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three strip as shown in Figure 12. Repeat to make 24—Block Three strips total.

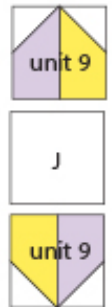
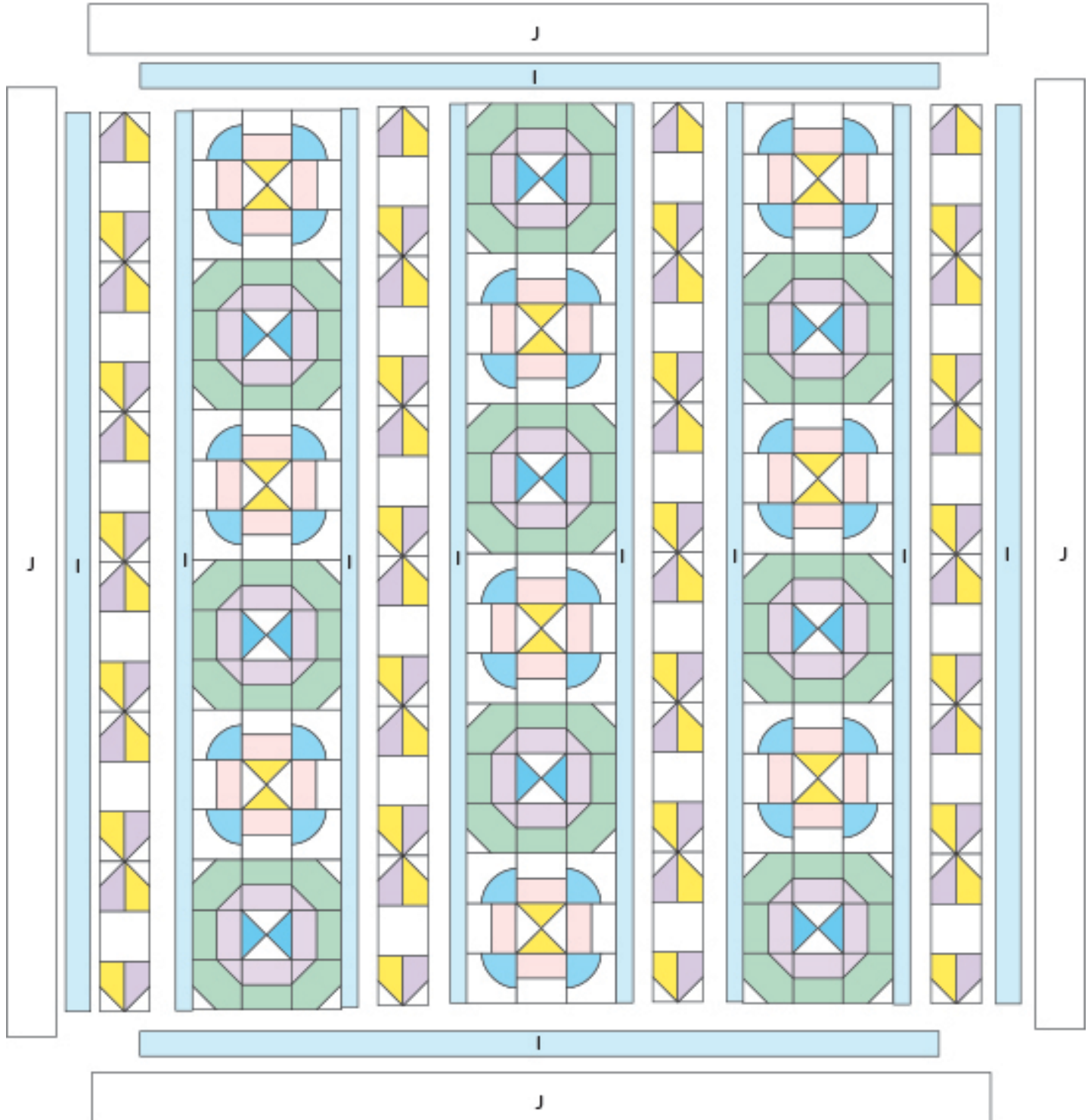

### Assemble Quilt Blocks and Sashing (refer to the quilt block assembly)

1. Sew together 6—Block Three strips end to end to make Row One. Repeat to make 4—Row One strips total.
2. Sew together 3—Block One squares and 3—Block Two squares, alternating them. Sew 1— $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the sewn blocks to make 1—Row Two strip. Repeat to make 3—Row Two strips total.
3. Sew together the 4—Row One strips and 3—Row Two strips, alternating them to make the quilt top. *NOTE: The center Block Two strip is flipped 180 degrees in the quilt layout.*
4. Sew 1—2" x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew 12" x  $48\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
5. Sew 1— $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $57\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew 1— $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $54\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
6. Sew all 6— $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips together end to end using a diagonal seam. Trim seam to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press seams open.

## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
