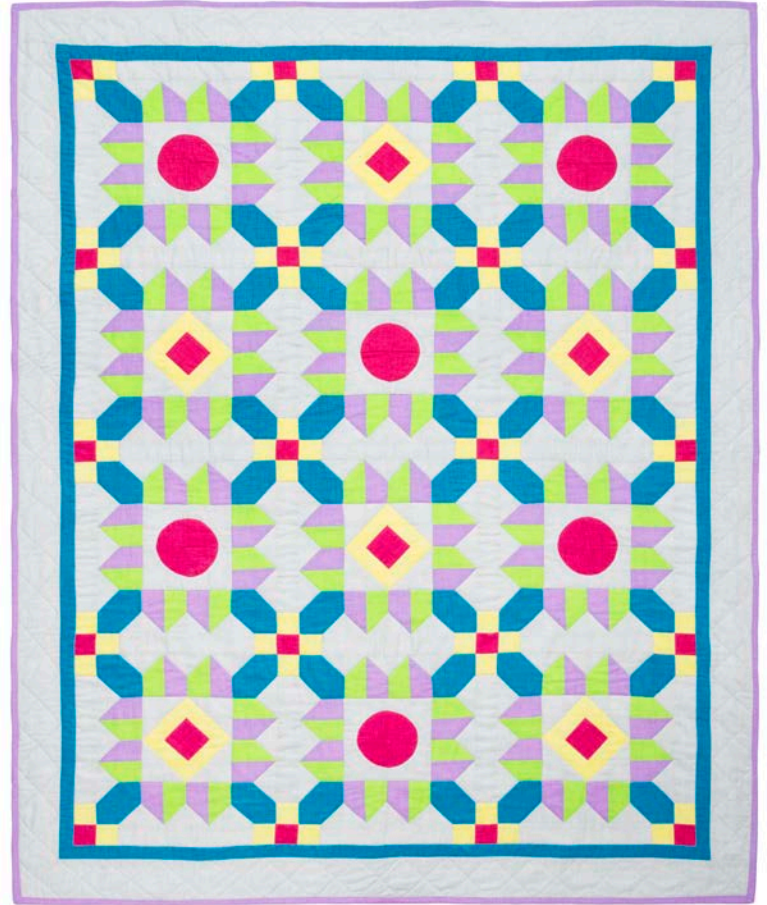


## GO! Qube 6" Electric Parade Quilt

### Dies Needed:

#### GO! Qube Mix & Match 6" Block (55775)

- GO! Square-2" (1½" Finished) (Shape 2)
- GO! Quarter Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (Shape 4)
- GO! Half Square Triangle-1½" Finished Square (Shape 5)
- GO! Square on Point-2 5/8" (2 1/8" Finished) (Shape 6)








- GO! Chisels-1½" x 3" Finished (Shape 9)
- GO! Signature Block-3" Finished (Shape 10)
- GO! Drunkard's Path-Arc Shape-3" Finished (Shape 11)
- GO! Drunkard's Path-Quarter Circle-3" Finished (Shape 12)

### Additional Dies Needed:

- GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
- GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032)

**Cutting Directions:**

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Lipstick Pink (A)		Cut 1—4½" x width of fabric (WOF) strip. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 20—1½" finished squares.	1/2 yard
Lipstick Pink (A)		Cut 1—3" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 6—squares on point.	Yardage included above
Lipstick Pink (A)		Cut 3—3" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 24—quarter circles.	Yardage included above
Neon Green (B)		Cut 48—6¼" x 2½" strips. Layer up to 6 layers of fabric <i>right side down</i> on die and cut 96—"right" chisels. Shift the strip to cut the next "right" chisels. Do not fanfold.	2/3 yards
Iris Purple (C)		Cut 48—6¼" x 2½" strips. Layer up to 6 layers of fabric <i>right side up</i> on die and cut 96—"left" chisels. Shift the strip to cut the next "left" chisels. Do not fanfold.	2/3 yards
Teal Blue (D)		Cut 5—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 48—signature blocks.	1 1/8 yards
Yellow (E)		Cut 2—4½" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 62—1½" finished squares.	2/3 yards
Yellow (E)		Cut 6—5" squares. Sub cut into 24—3" finished QSTs.	Yardage included above
Yellow (E)		Cut 3—5¼" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 24—1½" finished HSTs.	Yardage included above

Fabric Color	Shape & Number	Number of Shapes to Cut	Total Fabric Required
Mist White (F)		Cut 1—4½" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 4½" widths. Sub cut into 24—1½" finished squares.	2¾ yards
Mist White (F)		Cut 6—5¼" x WOF strip. Fanfold into 3" widths. Sub cut into 336—1½" finished HSTs.	Yardage included above
Mist White (F)		Cut 2—4" x WOF strips. Fanfold into 4" widths. Sub cut into 24—arc shapes.	Yardage included above

**Additional Cutting Instructions:**

- Teal Blue (D): Yardage included above
  - Cut 6—1½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-1½" (1" Finished) (55024). Sew the strips together with diagonal seams and cut 2—1½" x 56" strips and 2—2½" x 44½" strips for inner border.
- Mist White (F): Yardage included above
  - Cut 31—2" x 9½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2" (1½" Finished) (55025).
  - Cut 6—3½" x WOF strips using GO! Strip Cutter-3½" (3" Finished) (55032). Sew the strips together with diagonal seams and cut 2—3½" x 58" strips and 2—3½" x 50½" strips.

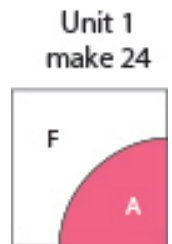
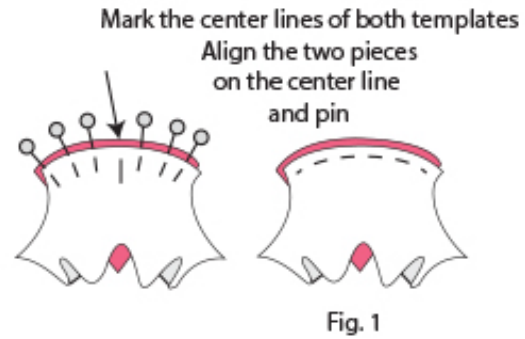
**Additional Fabrics Needed:**

- Binding: ½ yard
  - Cut 6—2½" strips using GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014) for binding.
- Batting: 58" x 72"
- Backing: 3¼ yards cut into 2—58" pieces. Sew the pieces together along the 58" length to make the backing.

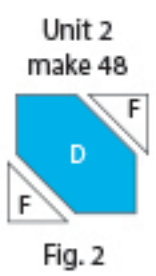
**Sewing Directions:**

*Press all seams open and use ¼" seams, unless otherwise indicated.*

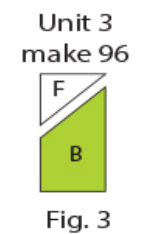
- Align the Fabric A quarter circle (Shape 12) and Fabric F arc shape (Shape 11) right sides together, matching the center mark on each piece. Pin the two pieces together at the center mark and then at each end. Carefully sew the two pieces together using a ¼" seam. Flip open the sewn unit and press to make 1—Unit 1 as shown in Figure 1. Repeat to make 24—Unit 1 blocks total.



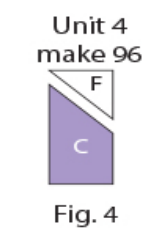
- Sew one Fabric F 1½" finished half square triangles (HST) (Shape 5) to the upper right corner and one Fabric F 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to the lower left corner of one Fabric D signature block (Shape 10) to make 1—3½" Unit 2 as shown in Figure 2. Repeat to make 48—Unit 2 blocks total.



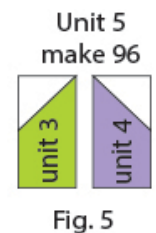
- Sew one Fabric F 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to upper left corner of the Fabric B right chisel (Shape 9) to make 1—2" x 3½" Unit 3 strip as shown in Figure 3. Repeat to make 96—Unit 3 strips.



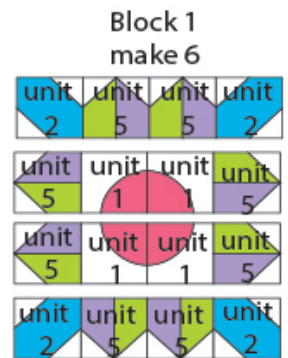
- Sew one Fabric F 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to upper right corner of Fabric C left chisel (Shape 9) to make 1—2" x 3½" Unit 4 strip as shown in Figure 4. Repeat to make 96—Unit 4 strips.



- Sew together 1—Unit 3 strip and 1—Unit 4 strip to make 1—3½" Unit 5 square as shown in Figure 5. Repeat to make 96—Unit 5 squares total.



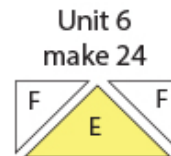
6. Follow the lay out in Figure 6 to sew together 4—Unit 1 squares, 4—Unit 2 squares and 8—Unit 5 squares to make 1—12½" Block One square. Repeat to make 6—Block One Squares total.

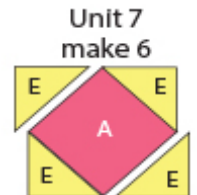
7. Sew one Fabric F 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to each short side of one Fabric E 3" finished quarter square triangle (QST) (Shape 4) to make a 2" x 3½" Unit 6 flying geese unit as shown in Figure 7. Repeat to make 24—Unit 6 flying geese units.

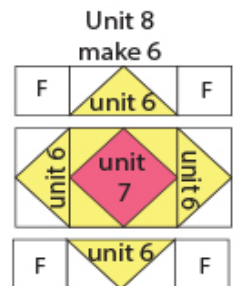
8. Sew together one Fabric E 1½" finished HST (Shape 5) to each side of one Fabric A square on point (Shape 6) to make a Unit 7 square as shown in Figure 8. Repeat to make 6—Unit 7 squares total.

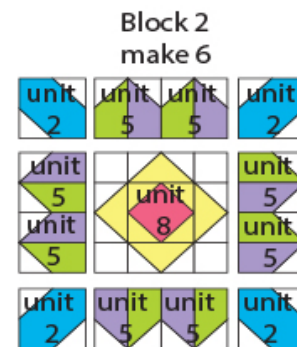
9. Sew together 4—Fabric F 1½" finished squares (Shape 2), 4—Unit 6 flying geese units and 1—Unit 7 square to make 1—6½" Unit 8 square as shown in Figure 9. Repeat to make 6—Unit 8 squares total.

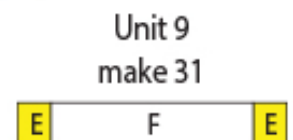
10. Follow the lay out in Figure 10 to sew together 4—Unit 2 squares, 8—Unit 5 squares and 1—Unit 8 square to make 1—12½" Block Two square. Repeat to make 6—Block Two squares total.

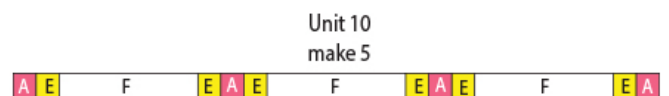
11. Sew together one Fabric E 1½" finished square (Shape 2) to each end of one 2" x 9½" Fabric F strip to make 1—2" x 12½" Unit 9 strip as shown in Figure 11. Repeat to make 31—Unit 9 strips total.

12. Sew together 4—Fabric A 1½" finished squares (Shape 2) and 3—Unit 9 strips, alternating them to make 1—Unit 10 strip. Repeat to make 5—Unit 10 strips total.



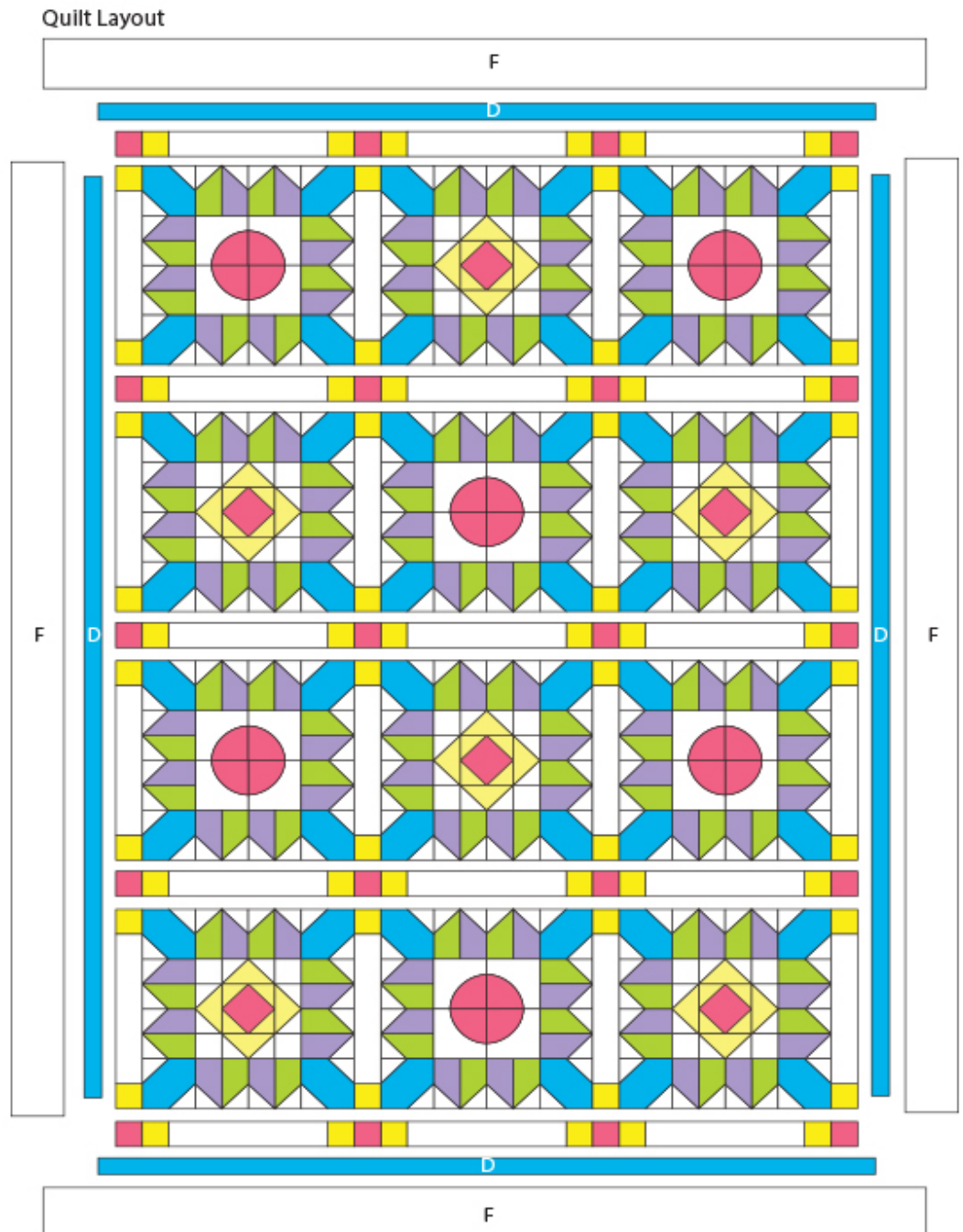

## Assemble Quilt Blocks and Sashing

(refer to the quilt lay out while assembling)

1. Sew together 4—Unit 9 strips, 2—Block One squares and 1—Block Two square, alternating the strips and the blocks to make Row 1. Repeat to make Row 3.
2. Sew together 4—Unit 9 strips, 2—Block Two squares and 1—Block One square, alternating the strips and the blocks to make Row 2. Repeat to make Row 4.
3. Sew together 5—Unit 10 strips and the block rows in numerical order, alternating them to make the quilt top.
4. Sew 1—1" x 56" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew 1—1½" x 44½" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
5. Sew 1—3½" x 58" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew 1—3½" x 50½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.



## Quilting and Finishing

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
