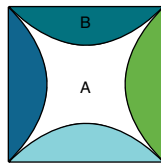
Project Specifications

Number of Blocks: 21

Make 21

Materials

- 11 fat quarters assorted coordinating blue and green prints
- ¾ yard blue/green plaid
- 2 yards coordinating light background print
- Backing 54" x 61"
- Batting 54" x 61"
- Neutral-color all-purpose thread
- Quilting thread to match
- GO! Dies:
 - GO! Rob Peter to Pay Paul-7" Finished (2-Die Set) (55068)
 - GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
 - GO! Strip Cutter-2¼" (1¾" Finished) (55083)
- Basic quilting tools and supplies

Die-Cutting Instructions

1. From each fat quarter, cut one 7½" x 18" rectangle; subcut two 7½" squares to make 22 C squares; discard one.

2. From each fat quarter, cut two 6" x 18" rectangles; subcut four 6" x 9" rectangles. Die-cut eight Rob Peter to Pay Paul B edges as shown in Figure 1 below from each fabric, totaling 168.

3. Cut six 9" by fabric width light background print strips; fan-fold 9" wide. Die-cut 21 Rob Peter to Pay Paul for A centers again referring to Figure 1 below.

4. Cut three 6" by fabric width light background print strips; fan-fold 6" wide. Using 2½" strip cutter die-cut six D-E strips.

5. Cut one 10" by fabric width strip and one 6" by fabric width strip from blue/green plaid; fan-fold strips 10" wide. Using 2¼" strip cutter die-cut six 2¼" strips for binding.

Completing Blocks & Rows

1. Arrange A, B and C pieces in seven rows referring to Figure 1, matching B edges to C squares and adding extra B edges to A pieces on the outside edges of rows. **Note:** B and C pieces will form circles throughout the quilt pieced center.

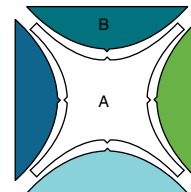
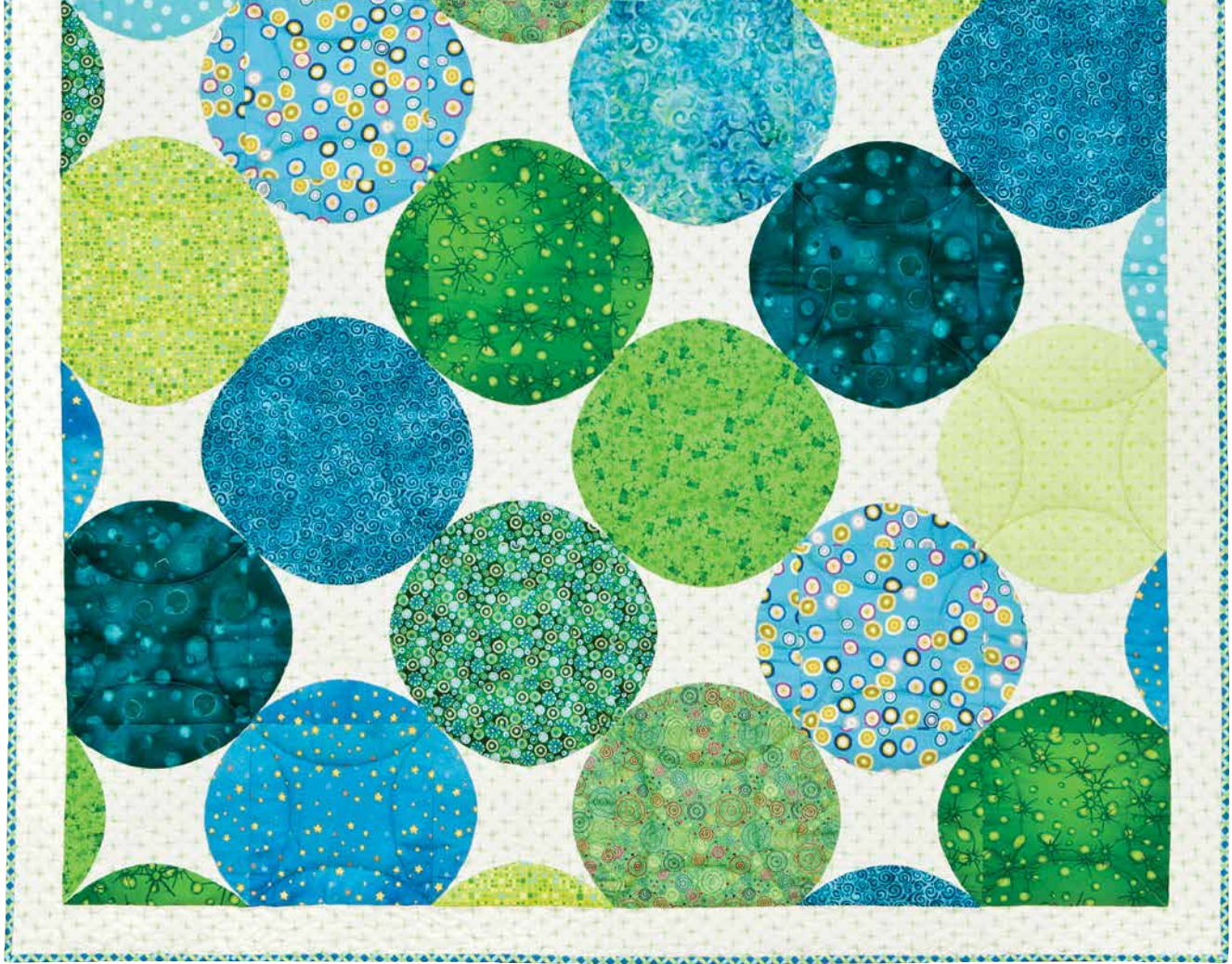

2. To complete one Rob Peter to Pay Paul block, select first A and corresponding B edges from row 1. With B on top of A, pin at center notches, curve ends and generously pin between notches referring to Figure 2. Carefully stitch curved seam and press toward B. Repeat to stitch all B edges to A to complete one block. Return completed block to arrangement and repeat to make 21 blocks.

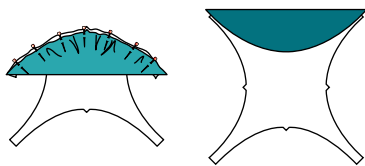

3. Join pieced Rob Peter to Pay Paul blocks to C squares as arranged referring again to Figure 1 to make seven rows, pressing seams in opposite directions.

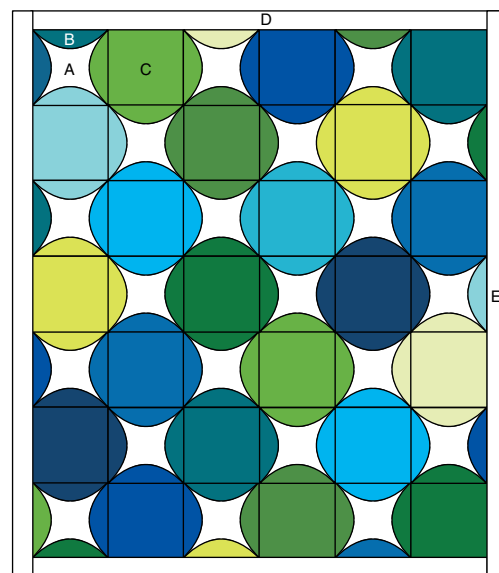
4. Join rows, matching seams, in order referring to Figure 1. Press seams in one direction.

Completing the Quilt

1. Join D-E strips on short ends to make one long strip, press seams to one side. Cut two 42½" D borders and two 53½" E borders.

2. Stitch D to top and bottom of quilt center and E to opposite sides. Press seams toward D and E.

3. Layer, quilt and bind with blue/green plaid 2¼" strips. ❖
