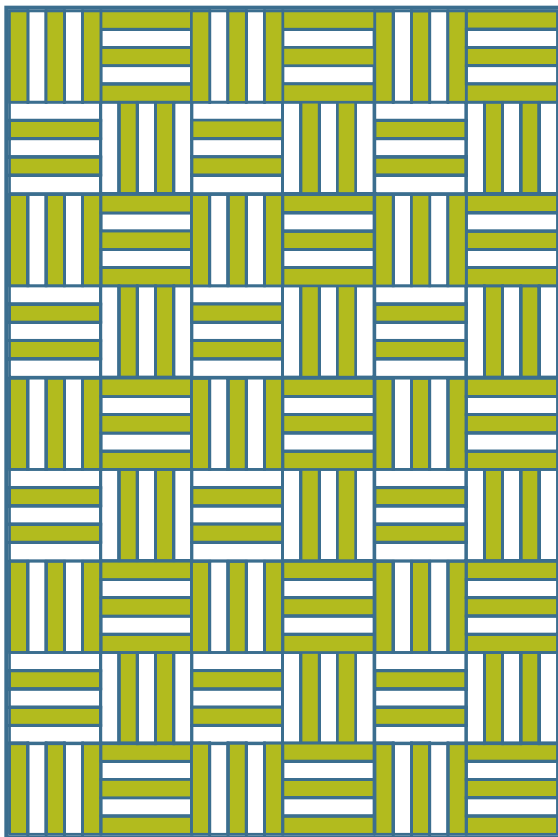


strip cutter-2"

finished block size 7½"

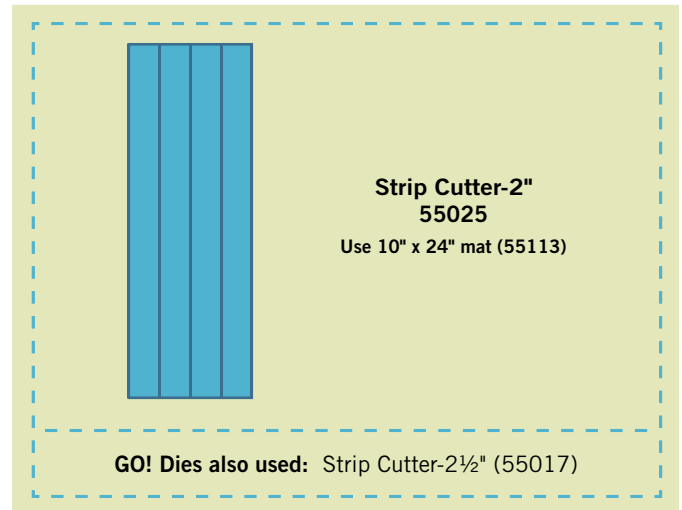


FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 2¼ yards fabric for dark strips and binding
- 1¾ yards fabric for light strips
- 2¾ yards backing fabric

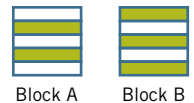
CUTTING DIRECTIONS

- Cut 27—2" wide strips across the width of light fabric
- Cut 28—2" wide strips across the width of dark fabric
- Cut 6—2½" strips across the width of dark fabric for binding



SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Make 24 Block A and 30 Block B.
2. Layout five fabric strips in chosen color order.
3. Make five strip sets for Block A and six strip sets for Block B.
4. Pin and sew strips right sides together.
5. Press seams toward dark fabric.
6. Measure width of strip set (approx. 8").
7. Cut five squares to this measurement across pieced unit.
8. Layout blocks according to diagram.
9. Pin and sew horizontal rows together.
10. Press seams of each row in opposite directions toward vertical stripes.
11. Pin and sew rows together to complete quilt top.
12. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.



QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
