squares & 4-patches to GO!

QUILT
finished size 48" x 72"

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- 1⅓ yards each of two fabrics for 4-patches
- 2¼ yards fabric for large squares
- ⅝ yard binding fabric
- 3¼ yards backing fabric

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

- Cut 96—3½" squares each from both 4-patch fabrics
- Cut 48—6½" squares from selected fabric
- Cut 7—2½" strips across width of fabric for binding

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Pin right sides together (RST) and sew 48, 4-patch units.
2. Layout 4-patch units and large squares for quilt according to diagram.
3. Pin (RST) and sew 4-patch units and squares together in horizontal rows.
4. Press seams of alternating rows to right or left.
5. Pin (RST) and sew rows together to complete quilt.
6. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.

QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

Quilter's Tip

Use AccuQuilt GO!™ Quilt Squares-6½" (55000) and Strip Cutter-2½" (55017) to cut binding strips!
