FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Triangle fabrics—use various scraps or fat quarters
- Binding fabric— $\frac{1}{2}$ yard
- Batting—63" x 89"
- Backing— $3\frac{1}{2}$ yards

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Triangle fabrics:

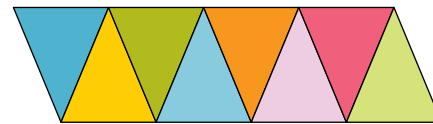
- Cut 448—isosceles triangles

Binding fabric:

- Cut $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips across the bias (need about 272")

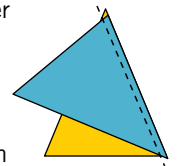
SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layout 28 isosceles triangles for one row of quilt.



Plus 20 more.

2. Pin and sew triangles right sides together with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Tips of triangles will extend beyond ends of triangles $\frac{1}{4}$ " as shown. The top and bottom edges of sewn rows should be straight. Adjust seam allowance width if necessary to achieve straight rows.
3. Press seams of first row toward the left.
4. Make a total of 16 rows.
5. Press seams of alternating rows in opposite directions.
6. Sew together rows to complete quilt top.
7. Press row seams toward bottom of quilt.



QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Pin or baste.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Sew bias binding to quilt, curving binding around side triangles.
