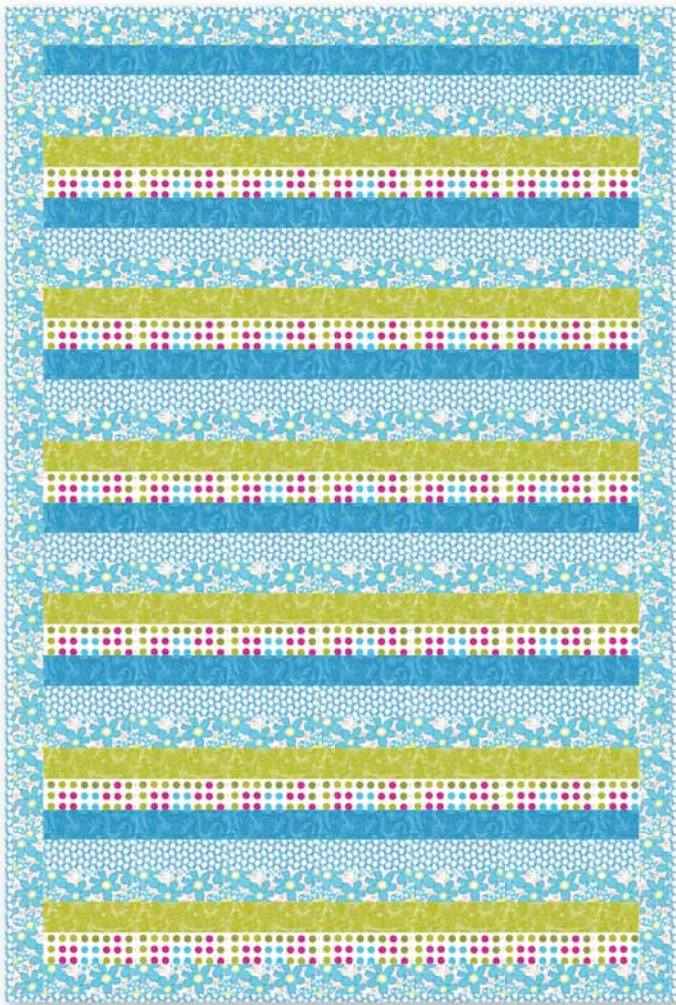


GO! Strips Quilt

finished size 44" x 80"



CUTTING DIRECTIONS

(Quilt center requires a total of 30 strips cut across the width of the fabrics)

Fabric 1:

- Cut 12—2½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF)

Fabric 2:

- Cut 13—2½" strips across the WOF

Fabric 3:

- Cut 6—2½" strips across the WOF

Fabric 4:

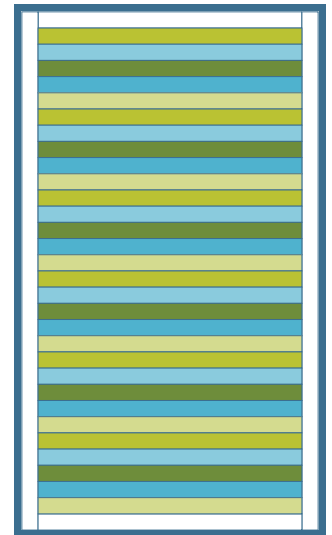
- Cut 6—2½" strips across the WOF

Fabric 5:

- Cut 6—2½" strips across the WOF

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layout five fabric strips in chosen color order.
2. Pin and sew strips right sides together.
3. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
4. Pin and sew four more sets of five strips.
5. Pin and sew strip sets together as shown in diagram.
6. Press seams toward bottom of quilt.
7. Pin and sew border strip to top and bottom of quilt center.
8. Even up sides of quilt center trimming off selvages.
9. Pin and sew two sets of two border strips together for side borders.
10. Pin and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (2" Finished) (55017)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1 yard for border and strips
- Fabric 2—1⅓ yards for strips and binding
- Fabric 3—½ yard for strips
- Fabric 4—½ yard for strips
- Fabric 5—½ yard for strips
- Backing—3 yards

QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
