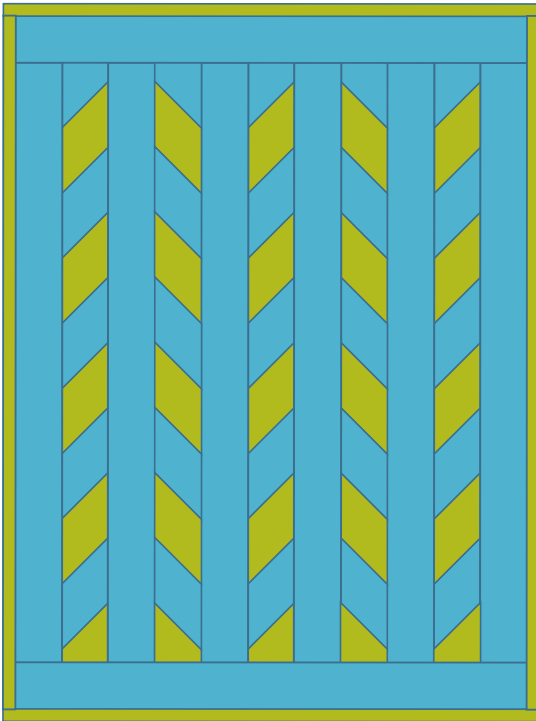


GO! Wavy Lap Throw

finished size 44" x 60"



GO® DIES USED

- Strip Cutter-4½" (55054)
- Strip Cutter-2½" (55017)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—2¾ yards fabric for diamonds and border
- Fabric 2—1⅝ yards fabric for diamonds and binding
- Backing Fabric—3½ yards
- Batting—50" x 66" rectangle

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

TIP: To create extra long strips, fan fold fabric along the lengthwise grain making sure to keep fabric within the end of the die blades.

Fabric 1:

- Cut 2—4½" x 61" strips along the lengthwise grain for top and bottom borders (trim as needed during quilt construction)
- Cut 6—4½" x 52½" strips along the lengthwise grain for vertical strips and side borders

CUTTING DIRECTIONS Cont.

- Cut 7—4½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF) for diamonds, sub cut 14, 4½" x 20" rectangles (one is not used), lay each 4½" x 20" rectangle on blades aligning long edge of strip with marked 45° line (see above). Cut two diamonds from each 4½" x 20" rectangle for a total of 25 diamonds.

Fabric 2:

- Cut 7—4½" strips across the WOF for diamonds, sub cut 14, 4½" x 20" rectangles (one is not used), lay each 4½" x 20" rectangle on blades aligning long edge of strip with marked 45° line (see above). Cut two diamonds from each 4½" x 20" rectangle for a total of 25 diamonds.
- Cut 6—2½" strips across WOF for binding

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Layout Fabric #1 and Fabric #2 diamonds for each vertical row according to quilt diagram.
2. Pin and sew diamonds together. Press seams toward darker fabric.
3. Layer five pieced sections in a stack. Trim to square up one end of stack. Trim pieced sections to 52½".
4. Label rows 1-5.
5. Layout Fabric #1 vertical strips and side borders with pieced sections.
6. Pin and sew vertical rows together. Press seams toward Fabric #1 vertical strips and side borders.
7. Add Fabric #1 border strips to top and bottom of quilt center adjusting length of strips as needed. Press seams toward border.

QUILTING AND FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Machine quilt with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.

NOTE: The diamonds in this throw are cut with Strip Cutter-4½". Lay a ruler with 45° angle on blade as shown. Mark with permanent marker or tape as a reference guide for fabric placement.
