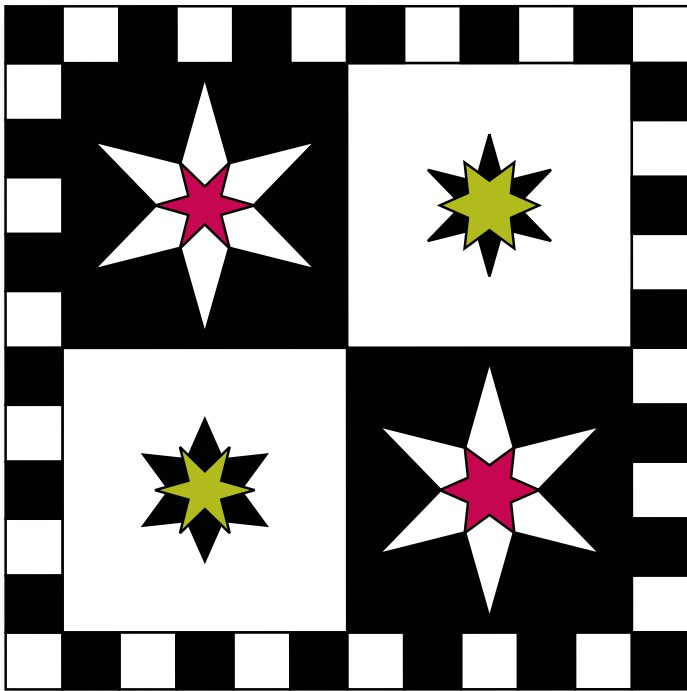


GO! 6 Point Stars Quilt

GO!® DIES USED

- GO! Star-6 Point (55312)
- GO! Star Medley-6 Point (55313)
- GO! Strip Cutter-2½" (55017 or 55014)

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—½ yard
- Fabric 2—½ yard
- Scraps—4 fabrics with fusible web backing for extra stars
- Fusible web—⅝ yard
- Backing—1 yard
- Batting—30" x 30"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric 1:

- Cut 2—2½" strips across the width of fabric (WOF)
- Cut 2—10½" squares
- Cut 1—wide medium star
- Cut 1—narrow medium star

Fabric 2:

- Cut 2—2½" strips across the WOF
- Cut 2—10½" squares
- Cut 2—large stars

Scraps:

- Cut 2—wide small stars
- Cut 2—narrow small stars

SEWING DIRECTIONS

1. Remove paper backing from star shapes.
2. Position stars on background squares as shown. Fuse according to manufacturer's instructions.
3. Machine appliqué edges of stars with a narrow zigzag or blanket stitch.
4. Lay out four star block units as shown and sew together.
5. Create two pairs of strips, each with one Fabric #1 and one Fabric #2 strip. Sew each pair together and press seam towards the darker fabric.
6. Cut each strip into 12, 2½" pieces for a total of 24 square units.
7. Lay out square units as shown in the diagram and sew together six units each for the top and bottom and five units each for the sides.
8. Add the sides to the center blocks, then add the top and bottom.

QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together. Quilt as desired.
3. Add binding, mitering corners.
