





Fall asleep under the stars. Combine Flying Geese with Four-Patch units to create the classic Eight-Pointed Star design.

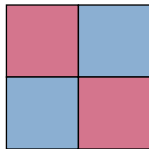

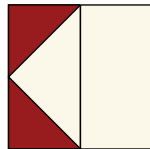

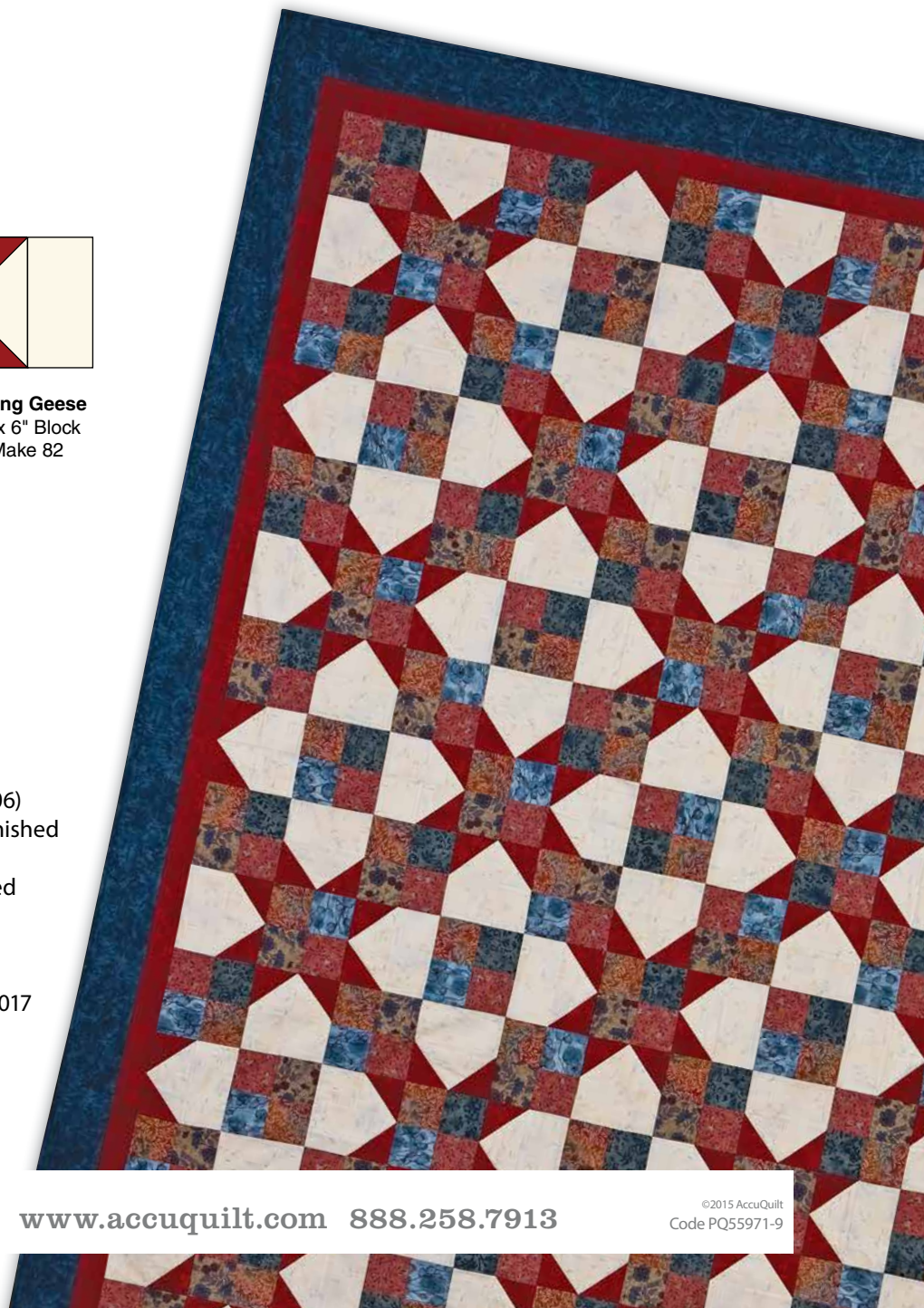

Materials

- 2 yards navy blue mottled
- 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards total rose print
- 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards total federal blue print
- 2 $\frac{5}{8}$ yards burgundy mottled
- 4 yards cream mottled
- Backing 86" x 110"
- Batting 86" x 110"
- Neutral-color all-purpose thread
- GO! Dies:
 - B: GO! Square-3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3" Finished) (55006)
 - D: GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (55002)
 - E: GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (55009)
 - H: GO! Rectangle-3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (3" x 6" Finished) (55005)
 - GO! Strip Cutter-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (2" Finished) (55017 or 55014)
 - Optional: GO! Strip Cutter-4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (4" Finished) (55054)
- Basic quilting tools and supplies



Die-Cutting Instructions

1. Cut 11–8" x width of fabric (WOF) strips rose print and fan-fold 4½" wide. Die-cut 166 B squares using GO! Square-3½" (55006) **Note:** If using smaller cuts of fabric or scraps, die-cut B squares individually or with strips 8" wide, according to fabric piece size.
2. Cut 11–8" x WOF strips federal blue print and fan-fold 4½" wide. Die-cut 166 B squares using GO! Square-3½" (55006).
3. Cut 12–4½" x WOF strips cream mottled, layer strips and die-cut 82 D triangles using GO! Quarter Square Triangle-6" Finished Square (55002).
4. Cut 6–9½" x WOF strips burgundy mottled and fan-fold 4½" wide. Die-cut 164 E triangles using GO! Half Square Triangle-3" Finished Square (55009).
5. Cut 11–7½" x WOF strips cream mottled and fan-fold 4½" wide. Die-cut 82 H rectangles using GO! Rectangle-3½" x 6½" (55005).
6. Cut one 25½" x fabric width strip burgundy mottled. With strip folded in half, fan-fold in 8½"-wide folds. Using the 2½" strip cutter, die-cut 9 strips for I/J borders.
7. Cut one 25½" x fabric width strip navy mottled. With strip folded in half, fan-fold in 8½"-wide folds. Using the 2½" strip cutter, die-cut 9 strips for binding.

Additional Cutting Instructions

Tip: Use GO! Strip Cutter die 4½" to cut borders.

1. Cut nine 4½" x fabric width strips navy blue mottled for K/L borders.

Completing the Four-Patch Blocks

1. Sew a federal blue B square to a rose B square. Press seam toward federal blue. Repeat to make 166 B/B units (Figure 1).

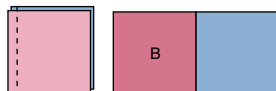

2. Sew B/B units together matching blue squares to rose squares to make 83 Four-Patch blocks (Figure 2). Press seams open to avoid bulk.

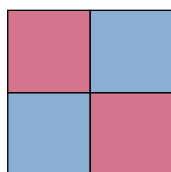

Completing the Flying Geese Blocks

1. Sew a burgundy mottled E triangle to both sides of a D cream mottled triangle as shown in Figure 3. Press seams toward E. Repeat to make 82 flying geese units.

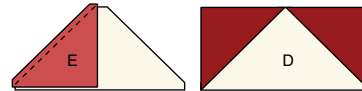

2. Sew the long cream edge of a flying geese unit to a long edge of a cream H rectangle (Figure 4). Press seam open to avoid bulk.

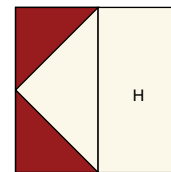

3. Repeat to make 82 Flying Geese blocks.

Completing the Quilt

1. Select six Four-Patch blocks and five Flying Geese blocks. Beginning with a Four-Patch block, lay out blocks, referring to Figure 5. Sew blocks together to make W row; press seams open to avoid bulk. Repeat to make a total of four W rows, referring to Figure 5.

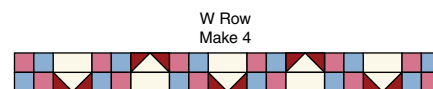

2. Sew X row in the same manner as W row, using six Flying Geese blocks and five Four-Patch blocks referring to Figure 6 for placement. Repeat to make a total of four X rows.

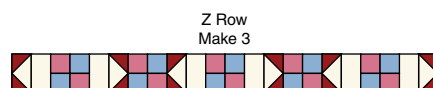
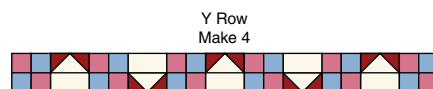
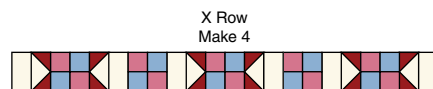

3. Sew Y rows in the same manner as W row, using six Four-Patch blocks and five Flying Geese blocks again referring to Figure 6. Repeat to make a total of four Y rows.

4. Sew Z row in the same manner as W row, using six Flying Geese blocks and five Four-Patch blocks again referring to Figure 6. Repeat to make a total of three Z rows.

5. Sew rows together in order shown in Figure 7, matching seams. Press seams open to avoid bulk.

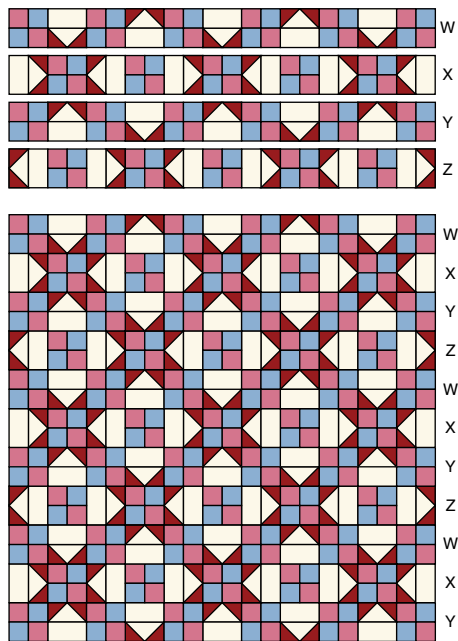

6. Sew I/J strips together at short ends; press seams open. Cut into two 66½" I border strips and two 94½" J border strips.

Tip

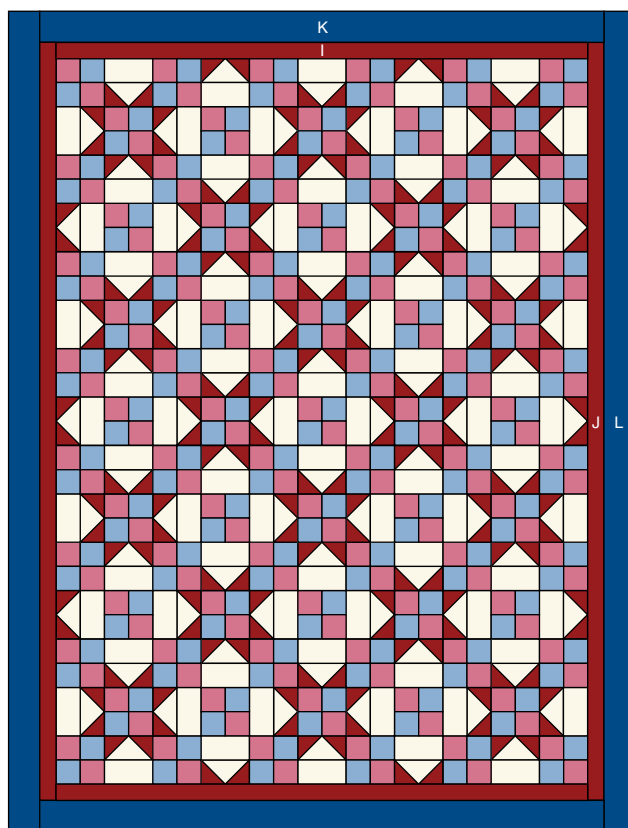
Set up the cutter on a sturdy table with ample space to work and lay out fabric. As you cut, label pieces and place in a project box.

7. Sew I borders to top and bottom of pieced center and J borders to sides, referring to Placement Diagram.

8. Sew K/L strips together at short ends; press seams open. Cut into two 70½" K border strips and two 102½" L border strips.

9. Sew K borders to top and bottom of pieced center and L borders to sides, referring to Placement Diagram.

10. Layer, quilt and bind with navy mottled 2½" strips. ❖
