

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

- Fabric 1—1¼ yard
- Fabric 2—1½ yards (includes border and binding)
- Fabric 3—1 yard
- Fabric 4—¾ yard
- Backing—3 yards
- Batting—51" x 51"

CUTTING DIRECTIONS

Fabric 1:

- Cut 72—pairs of Triangles in Square (TIS) side triangles
- Cut 216—1½" finished half square triangles

Fabric 2:

- Cut 5—3½" strips across the width of the fabric (WOF) for outer border
- Cut 5—2½" strips across the WOF for binding
- Cut 9—3½" squares
- Cut 18—3" finished half square triangles
- Cut 36—1½" finished half square triangles

Fabric 3:





- Cut 4—1¾" strips across the WOF for inner border
- Cut 36—TIS center triangles
- Cut 9—3" finished half square triangles
- Cut 54—1½" finished half square triangles

Fabric 4:














- Cut 36—TIS center triangles
- Cut 9—3" finished half square triangles
- Cut 54—1½" finished half square triangles

SEWING DIRECTIONS

NOTE: Press seams toward darker fabric or for the least bulk or as directed.

1. Lay out pieces for one block according to photo. Pay close attention to fabric color placement as you complete block sections.
2. Pin and sew 1½" finished half square triangles together using one Fabric #1 triangle and one Fabric #2 triangle. Make 36. 
3. Pin and sew 1½" finished half square triangles together using one Fabric #1 triangle and one Fabric #3 triangle. Make 54. 
4. Pin and sew 1½" finished half square triangles together using one Fabric #1 triangle and one Fabric #4 triangle. Make 54. 
5. Pin and sew four, 1½" finished half square triangle units together to form each corner square. 

SEWING DIRECTIONS Cont.

6. Pin and sew Fabric #1 TIS side triangles to Fabric #2 TIS center triangles, pressing after each addition. Make 36. 
7. Pin and sew Fabric #1 TIS side triangles to Fabric #3 TIS center triangles, pressing after each addition. Make 36. 
8. Pin and sew completed TIS units together to form diamond shape. Press seam open. Make 18 Fabric #2 and 18 Fabric #3. 
9. Pin and sew 2, Fabric #1, 1½" finished half square triangles together to form larger triangles for around center square. Press seams open. Make 36. 
10. Pin and sew completed Fabric #1 larger triangle units to each side of center square, pressing after each addition. Make 9. 
11. Pin and sew 3" finished half square triangles to each corner of combined center square unit. Press after each addition. Make 9. 
12. Pin and sew block sections into rows. Press seams open. 
13. Pin and sew rows together to complete block. Press seams open. Make 9 blocks. 
14. Layout blocks according to color photo/illustration. 
15. Pin and sew into rows. Press seams open. 
16. Pin and sew rows together to complete quilt center. Press seams open. 
17. Add Fabric #3, 1¾" strips for inner border. Press seams toward inner border. 
18. Add Fabric #2, 3½" strips for outer border. Press seams toward inner border. 

QUILTING & FINISHING

1. Layer batting between quilt top and backing.
2. Pin or baste layers together.
3. Model was machine quilted with an all-over design.
4. Add binding, mitering corners.
